**Order:-**

As per ref. letter No. (1) Executive Engineer, Irrigation Project Division No.4, Rajpipla has submitted proposal for diversion of 3-26-00 Ha. Government land out of which 2500 Sq.m. from 2-25-00 Ha. of land from Survey No. 84 & 3-01-00 Ha. from Survey No. 95 to Government's Forest Department for work of Karjan Right Bank High level Canal, H.R. under Forest (Conservation) Act – 1980.

From the letter of Mamlatdar Shri, Garudeshwar mentioned in the preamble (2) investigating the proposal of the applicant's office, the instrumental papers along with the investigation report have been received. According to which 2-25-00 ha. land of Survey No. 84 & 3-01-00 ha. land of Survey no. 95 of Village Kalimakwana, Ta. Garudeshwar, Dist. Narmada is undulating. Currently this land is open. No use is made of this land. This land recorded as Government waste land by note no. 796 Khalsa. Mamlatdar Shri Garudeshwar has given a positive opinion to transfer the above mentioned land adjacent to the forest area to the Forest Department.

According to the report received from Mamlatdar Shri Garudeshwar, a proposal was made to the Revenue Department, Gandhinagar for approval from the letter mentioned in the preamble (3) here. In view of which the above mentioned lands have been allowed to be transferred to the Forest Department of the Government under Administrative Order-3 from the letter shown in the Prologue-4 of the Revenue Department, Gandhinagar.

Provision has been made to transfer land to other departments / accounts of the Government under Administrative Order-3 of Gujarat Land Revenue Rules-1972.

For the work of Karjan Right Bank High level Recharge Canal / H.R. 3-25-00 Ha. land of Forest Department is to be diverted under forest (Conservation) Act – 1980 against which total

Government Waste land of 32600 Sq.m. (3-26-00 Ha.) of Village Kalimakwana, Ta. Garudeshwar, Dist. Narmada out of which 30100 Sq.m. land is from Survey No. 95 (Old survey no. 139) & 22500 Sq.m. land from Survey No. 84 (Old Survey no. 126) is ordered to be transferred subjected to conditions as mentioned below to "Forest & Environment Department, Gujarat State, Gandhinagar", & possession is to be given to Deputy Forest Conservator, Narmada Forest Department, Narmada under Administrative Order-3 of Gujarat Land Revenue Rules-1972.

**Conditions:-**

1. According instruction no. 4 of Government's Revenue Department resolution no. JMN-3907-1993-A dt. 18/01/2008 in the aforesaid land 7x12 will be in the name of "Shri Government" & Second owner department / account's name will be (Forest & Environment Department, Gujarat State, Gandhinagar).
2. Other uses of this land cannot be made without permission.
3. The land in question cannot be transferred or relocated in any way. The land in question has to be returned to the revenue department on the occasion of transfer of land transfer purpose.
4. If any dispute arises in the court regarding the land in question, it will be the responsibility of the office to defend it and its administrative department will be responsible for the expenses incurred.
5. Instead of proposed land Forest Department will have to give 3-25-00 Ha. land owned by them to Karjan Irrigation Scheme for Karjan Right Bank High Level Recharge Canal, H.R.
6. No person / institution or any other means may transfer without prior approval.
7. Regarding the area of the land in question, the District Inspector, Land Office Narmada, Rajpipla will have to hand over the possession of the land and after measuring the said land at the government's expense, the boundary will have to be marked and the map will have to be submitted.
8. Mamlatdar Shri, Garudeshwar will have to record the said order in the records at the village office.
9. In case of sublease/PPP/transfer/acceptance of court order/sale regarding allotted land, the concerned department will have to get approval after consulting the revenue department and finance department without delay.
10. The order will be revoked for violation of any of the above condition or conditions and the possession of the land including Imla will be recovered.
