In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government Of India's Letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act,2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that Forest Land proposed to be diverted in favour of RELIANCE JIO INFOCOMM LTD for the formation of the art Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) (Purpose for diversion of forest land) in Coimbatore District.

3. Certificate issued to concern as per the Forest Protect Act and the work must be carried out without any harm to Forest animals subject to safely laws, objective of Public Welfare and encourage Extension of Tele Communication of the country.

It is further certified that

- a. Certified that the proposal has been examined with reference to ensuring compliance of Scheduled Tribes and other traditional Forest Dwellers (recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006.
- b. Certified that the Scheduled Tribal and Traditional Forest Dwellers (recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 will not attract to the present case of forest land proposed for diversion for laying Optical Fiber Cable in Nellithurai Reserved Forests, Thadagam Reserved Forests, Anaikatti South Reserved Forests, Anaikatti North Reserved Forests, Nilgiris Eastern Slop Reserved Forests, Gobinari Reserved Forests, and Melur Slop Reserved Forests as there is no Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers in this Proposed area and no rights are there to be Settled.
