DETAIL NOTE ON THE PROJECT

C1

CONSTRUCTION OF AMBULANCE ROAD NEAR NEW COURT COMPLEX, CHAKKEDHAR, SHIMLA

The Municipal Corporation has been receiving requests from the residents of the area Chakkerdhar, Near New Judicial Complex, Shimla for quite some time. The matter has been discussed at various levels. After detailed discussions with various stakeholders and persistent demand of the public it has been decided to take up the construction of Ambulance Road near The New Judicial Courts Complex, Chakker, Shimla.

The proposed road is having 262 Mtrs. length and falls in Municipal Corporation Area, Shimla. For a long time a kacha road has been passing through this area and was being used by the residents of this area and the surrounding villages. Further this road was serving as shortcut for the commuters, most of these people are the office goers of the H.P. University, H.P. Agriculture Deptt., Central Govt. Printing Press. However recently the New Distt. Court Complex is constructed and the existing Kacha road is blocked by the Court authorities. Now only a very thin pagdandi with very steep gradients is left. As a result the residents of the area as well as the commuters are facing severe hardships.

Moreover the area is highly fire prone as it is surrounded by the thick Pine forests and every year fire breaks out in this area in the summers. The Fire Tender cannot reach the Jungle, hence the fire causes extensive damages the Pine jungle and also endangers the life and the property of the residents. Further the residents of the village Dhar face lot of problems to provide the medical aid to the patients as the ambulance also cannot reach the area. There have been casualties for want of timely medical aid and some people fell down on the narrow PAGDANDI and injured themselves.

Therefore it is proposed that road to construct an AMBULANCE ROAD OF ONLY 262 Mtr. Length which will help the residents of the area in case of forest fire and medical emergency. This also helps the hundreds of the commuters and save their time and energy in reaching their destination in a short time and distance. Moreover the area is attracting lot of development activities in view of the New Distt. Court Complex and other offices. The proposed road will help a great deal in the development activities in the area. The other benefits of the road shall be better health services, better education, business opportunities etc. Also during the construction of the said road employment of about 5000 man days is likely to be generated. There are expected to be further generation of over 50000 man days per year on account of development activities which are expected to take place. Thus the population residing in the area and the surrounding villages will be benefited in various ways by the construction of the said road.

During the survey work of the proposed road, maximum efforts were made to involve the minimum forest land but it was observed that there is no other alternate alignment is possible for the proposed road. The proposed road is require to use the forest land measuring 0.112368 hact. Comprising in Khsra No. 280/1 and 1580/1473/1348/703/2/2 in Mohal Badaï, sankat Mochan, Disstt. Shimla i.e. r-29(Sandal) in the jurisdiction of Taradevi Beat and UPF- 206 (Badhai), Mohal sankat Mochan in the Tuti kandi Beat in Shoghi Block, Shimla . The use of Forest land is in evitable.

The benefits / facilities likely to accrue are many times more in comparison of the ill effects occurring from the constructions of the proposed road. However all possible efforts / safe guards shall be made to minimize and mitigate any ill effects of the proposed construction. The muck / debris likely to be produced during the construction shall be locally disposed/ dumped by filling behind retaining walls etc. and cutting and filling method within the proposed required / acquired width (5/7 mtrs) of the road.


Keeping in view the demands of the Public, necessity / urgency and importance of the road the proposal has been made for the construction of the Ambulance road near New Disstt Court Complex, Chakker dhar of only 262 mtr. Lengh.

Accordingly the estimate amounting to Rs. 8.33 lacs only has been framed by the undersigned Er. H.K. Gupta, Executive Engineer, (R&B), Municipal Corporation, Shimla. The estimate has been prepared to cover the portable cost of the work and is being submitted for obtaining technical sanction/ approval from the State Technical Agency. The stipulated period of the time for the completion of work is 3 months from the start of the work subject to availability of fund and approval of the estimate.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Municipal Corporation has been receiving requests from the residents of the area chakkerdhar, Near New judicial Complex, Shimla for quite some time. The matter has been discussed at various level. After detailed discussions with various stakeholders and persistent demand of the public it has been decided to take up the construction of Ambulance Road near The New Judicial Courts Complex, Chakker, Shimla.

2.0 COST OF PROJECT

Cost of Construction of the Road	Rs. 8.33 Lacs

TOTAL	Rs. 9.00 Lacs

3.0 MEANS OF FINANCE

The municipal Corporation ,Shimla shall make contribution from its own sources and shall also obtain the contribution from the residents of the area to finance the project. Having regards to the resources available with corporation and the contribution expected to be received from the residents it shall not be difficult to complete the project.

4.0 THE PROJECT

The project is for CONSTRUCTION OF THE AMBULANCE ROAD NEAR THE NEW JUDICIAL COURTS COMPLEX, CHAKKER DHAR, SHIMLA. The proposed road is having 262 Mtrs. length and falls in Municipal Cororation Area, Shimla. For a long time a kacha road has been passing through this area and was being used by the residents of this area and the surrounding villages. Further this road was serving as shortcut for the commuters; most of these people are the office goers of the H.P. University. H.P. Agriculture Deptt., Central Govt. Printing Press. However recently the New Disstt. Court Complex is constructed and the existing Kacha road is blocked by the Court authorities. Now only a very thin pagdandi with very steep gradients is left. As a result the residents of the area as well as the commuters are facing sever hardships. The likely cost of the project is Rs. 9.00 lacs.

Moreover the area is highly fire prone as it is surrounded by the thick Pine forests and every year fire breaks out in this area in the summers. The Fire Tender cannot reach the Jungle, hence the fire causes extensive damages the Pine jungle and also endangers the life and the property of the residents. Further the residents of the village Dhar face lot of problems to provide the medical aid to the patients as the ambulance also cannot reach the area. There have been casualties for want of timely medical aid and some people fell down on the narrow PAGDANDI and injured themselves.

Therefore it is proposed that road to construct an AMBULANCE ROAD OF ONLY 262 Mtr. Length which will help the residents of the area in case of forest fire and medical emergency. This also helps the hundreds of the commuters and save their time and energy in reaching their destination in a short time and distance. Moreover the area is attracting lot of development activities in view of the New Disstt. Court Complex and other offices. The proposed road will help a great deal in the development activities in the area. The other benefits of the road shall be better health services, better education, business opportunities etc. Also during the construction of the said road employment of about 5000 man days is likely to be generated. There are expected to be further generation of over 50000 man days per year on account of development activities which are expected to take place. Thus the population residing in the area and the surrounding villages will be benefited in various ways by the construction of the said road.

During the survey work of the proposed road, maximum efforts were made to involve the minimum forest land but it was observed that there is no other alternate alignment is possible for the proposed road. The proposed road is require to use the forest land measuring 0.112368 hact. Comprising in Khsra No. 280/1 and 1580/1473/1348/703/2/2 in Mohal Badai, sankat Mochan, Disstt. Shimla i.e. r-29(Sandal) in the jurisdiction of Taradevi Beat and UPF- 206 (Badhai), Mohal sankat Mochan in the Tuti kandi Beat in Shoghi Block, Shimla . The use of Forest land is in evitable.

The benefits / facilities likely to accrue are many times more in comparison of the ill effects occurring from the constructions of the proposed road. However all possible efforts / safe guards shall be made to minimize and mitigate any ill effects of the proposed construction. The muck / debris likely to be produced during the construction shall be locally disposed/ dumped by filling behind retaining walls etc. and cutting and filling method within the proposed required / acquired width (5/7 mtrs) of the road.

Keeping in view the demands of the Public, necessity / urgency and importance of the road the proposal has been made for the construction of the Ambulance road near New Disstt Court Complex, Chakker dhar of only 262 mtr. Length.

The proposal has already been approved by the General House of the Municipal Corporation, Shimla. Other necessary approvals required for the purpose have also been obtained.

Accordingly the estimate amounting to Rs. 8.33 lacs only has been framed by the undersigned Er. H.K. Gupta, Executive Engineer, (R&B), Municipal Corporation, Shimla. The estimate has been prepared to cover the portable cost of the work and is being submitted for obtaining technical sanction/ approval from the State Technical Agency. The stipulated period of the time for the completion of work is 3 months from the start of the work subject to availability of fund and approval of the estimate.

5.0 IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE

The Ambulance Road is proposed to be Constructed in 3 months when the same is approved.

6.0 PERMISSIONS

- i. The General House of the Corporation has already approved this project.
- ii. The NOC from the Disstt. Administration about the non availability of any other alternative space, Essentiality Certificate and Under the FRA has been obtained,
- iii. Joint Survey by the Disstt. Administration and the Forest Deptt. Has been done.

7.0 COST – BENEFITS OF THE PROJECT

The cost of the project is estimated at Rs. 9.00 lacs.

The proposed project is likely to yield following SOCIO – ECONOMIC BENEFITS

The life and the property of residents of the area in case of forest fire and medical emergency shall be saved.

This also helps the hundreds of the commuters and save their time and energy in reaching their destination in a short time and distance.

The area is attracting lot of development activities in view of the New Disstt. Court Complex and other offices.

The proposed road will help a great deal in the development activities in the area.

The other benefits of the road shall be better health services, better education, business opportunities etc.

During the construction of the said road employment of about 5000 man days is likely to be generated. There are expected to be further generation of over 50000 man days per year on account of development activities which are expected to take place.

The benefits that are likely to accrue after the implementation of the project are far outweighing the cost of the project. The population residing in the area and the surrounding villages will be benefited enormously in various ways by the construction of the said road. It is therefore recommended for the speedy approval.
