 Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.  
 The kilometre stone numbers along roads, railway and canals are shown in slant type, e.g. '5' whereas distance numbers are shown in upright type e.g. '5'.  
 Unmetalled roads and cart tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use hoses along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.  
 Important buildings are shown in black.
