It is submitted that the Govt of India vide reference 7<sup>th</sup> cited has conveyed Central Government **in-principle (Stage.I) approval** under Section 2 of Forest (C) Act, 1980, for Diversion of **2.425 ha in Kagaznagar forest division** under erstwhile Adilabad District **presently Komaram Bheem Asifabad District**, for laying of Pipe Line and Construction of Structures in **Segment-22/4 (Kagaznagar)** under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project, in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Nirmal. The above orders have been communicated to all the concerned officers with instructions to submit condition-wise compliance report in the matter, vide reference 7<sup>th</sup> cited.

Accordingly, the District Forest Officer, KomaramBheem Asifabad/Forest Divisional Officer, Kagaznagar has obtained compliance of conditions from the User Agency and submitted the condition-wise compliance report together with its enclosures to I/c Conservator of Forests, Adilabad, which is received in this office through reference 9<sup>th</sup> cited with remarks from Conservator of Forests, Adilabad. A copy of reference 9<sup>th</sup> cited together with its enclosures **in triplicate** are enclosed herewith.


