**Sub:** Diversion of **5.237 ha** of forest land in Sy No. 92, 156, 157 & 159 of Marashettihalli Village, Gubbi Taluk, Tumakuru District for construction of 110 KV D/C Narrow Based Towers (KPTCL Design) for shifting of existing 110 KV S/C Nittur-Doddaguni Lines at proposed HAL factory land premises near Bidarehallada Kavalu Village in favour of the Executive Engineer, Major Works Division, KPTCL, Tumakuru

With reference to the above subject, the Government of India vide Ref (1) has accorded 'in-principle' (Stage-I) approval under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to certain conditions stipulated therein. The same was communicated by this office vide Ref (2) to the User Agency and field officers seeking Compliance Report in respect of conditions of Stage-I approval.

In response, the User Agency vide Ref (3) has submitted the condition-wise Compliance Report along with relevant document in respect of conditions of Stage-I approval to the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Tumakuru Division, who vide Ref (4)



has, after verification, submitted it to Chief Conservator of Forests, Hassan Circle and who in turn has vide Ref (5) submitted the same to this office.

Based on the report received from the field officers, the status of the condition-wise compliance in respect of conditions of Stage-I approval is as follows.

Condition of Stage-I approval dated 15-03-2018	Status of compliance
1. The legal Status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.	The legal status of forest land remains unchanged and it will be monitored by the Forest Department in future.
2. The demarcation of the forest area being diverted shall be carried out by erecting cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of User Agency, before Stage-II Approval.	User Agency has demarcated the diverted forest land by erecting 210 cement concrete pillars duly numbered all along the periphery.
3. The cost of raising Compensatory Afforestation over double the degraded forest land over an extent of 10.474 ha. of Manchaladore RF, in Sy.No.110 of Hoovinakatte Village, Gubbi Taluk, Tumakuru District shall be realized from the User Agency.	<p>The User Agency has paid an amount of Rs. <b>56,62,200/- towards</b> CA charges for 18.874 ha @ Rs. 3.00 lakh per hectare to CAMPA Account through FC web portal in the following installments.</p> <p>i. Rs. 28,48,928/- on 17-04-2018 (included in total Rs. 61,27,290/- paid on the day)</p> <p>ii. The state Government shall charge the Net Present value of the diverted forest land of 5.237 ha form the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03-2008 and 09-05-2008 in IA Nos. 826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202/1995.	<p>The User Agency has paid an amount of Rs. <b>32,78,362/- towards</b> Net Present Value for 5.237 ha @ Rs. 6.26 lakh per hectare to CAMPA Account through FC web portal on 17-04-2020.</p> <p>The copy of payment page print taken from FC Web portal is already enclosed above as <b>ANNEXURE-I</b>.</p>

Additional Amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish and undertaking to this effect.	The User Agency has submitted an Undertaking dated 05-11-2019 in this regard. <b>ANNEXURE -III.</b>
6.	User Agency should ensure that the compensatory levies are deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank online only. Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of Stage-I clearance.	The User Agency has already complied with the condition as mentioned against the Condition No. 3, 4 and 8.
7.	Necessary certificates/documents under the scheduled tribes and other traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Environment and Forests vide letter No.11-9/1998-Forest (Conservation) (Pt) dated 05-07-2013 shall be furnished before stage-II clearance. In view of the above mentioned compliance to conditions of Stage-I approval as reported by the field officers, it is requested to move the matter with the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Regional Office (Southern Zone) Bengaluru to accord final (Stage-II) approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 5.237 ha of forest land in Sy No. 92, 156, 157 & 159 of Marashettihalli Village, Gubbi Taluk, Tumakuru District for construction of 110 KV D/C Narrow Based Towers (KPTCL Design) for shifting of existing 110 KV S/C Nittur-Doddaguni Lines at proposed HAL factory land premises near Bidarehallada Kavalu Village in favour of the Executive Engineer, Major Works Division, KPTCL, Tumakuru for a period of twenty (20) years.
