It is submitted that the Government of India vide reference 2nd cited has conveyed central Government in-principle (Stage-I) approval under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980, for diversion of forest land to an extent of 1.245 Ha of forest land in Bhupalpally division of Jayashankar District, for laying of pipe line and construction of structures for Segment-15/7 (Manthani WLM), for providing drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project, in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Karimnagar, subject to compliance of conditions stipulated therein and the Pri. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad in the reference 1st cited above has requested to raise the demand note to the user agency for deposition of funds. The details are as follows.

As per the guidelines issued by the MoEFF&CC, GoI (Ad-hoc CAMPA Wing) remittance for compensatory levies shall be through e-payment portal of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change only. To be deposit amounts into Adhoc CAMPA account, the details of demand to be uploaded at forestclearance.nic.in against the project by User Agency. After vetting of the demand by Nodal Officer, the User Agency has to generate the challan and make payment against the challan generated. The detailed procedure for generation of Challan and deposition of funds is available at www.forestclearance.nic.in portal.

Further the Pri. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad reference 1st cited above has issued instructions that, the charges for felling, logging, transportation of project affected trees and the funds towards expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges etc., should be deposited with the Divisional Forest Officers (now DFOs/FDOs) concerned and the work should be undertaken departmentally in order to ensure that the task of felling / transportation / stone pillars etc., The details of the account number of the Forest Divisional Officer, Bhupalpally are as follows.


Further, the Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Karimnagar is requested to comply with the following

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the central government in two widely circulated daily news paper one in vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
2. The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

The Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Karimnagar is informed that the transfer of forest land to user agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval (or) working permission whichever is earlier. The Stage - I approval will be automatically revoked, if the compliance is not received within five years.


The Additional Principle Chief Conservator of Forest (FCA), TS, Hyderabad is requested to accord necessary approval to issue demand notice to the User Agency.

With reference to the subject cited above, it is submitted that for Stage -I approval for diversion of 7.762 Ha of forest land (Mahadevpur Division - 5.00 Ha + Bhupalpally Division - 1.245 Ha + Peddapally division - 1.517 Ha (0.758:WL + 0.759:ESZ) for laying of pipe line and construction of structures for Segment-15/7 (Manthani) for providing safe drinking water - under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project - in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Karimnagar and communicated by the Pr.I.CCF(HoFF) for raising of Demand. Accordingly, Demand Notice issued vide this office reference 3rd cited to the User Agency for an amount of Rs.54,82,770/-.

Further, it is also requested to furnish the copies of Paper Clippings about the publishing of forest clearance etc. as instructed by the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana, Hyderabad vide reference 1st cited above.

Therefore, it is requested to refer all the references in connection in this matter with utmost care and furnish the required information / condition wise compliance report as called in this case urgently for taking further course of action.
