It is submitted that vide references cited, the Stage I approval granted for "Diversion of 0.1347 ha of forest land for Establishment of KGBV Girls Residential School at Ananthapet (V) of Nirmal Mandal in Compt. No. 972 of Chincholi Forest Block of Nirmal Range of Nirmal Division has been communicated by the Prl.CCF (HoFF) for raising of demands over the user Agency.

The Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad has further requested the DFOs/FDOs to prepare the demand notice to be issued to the User Agency (UA) in consultation with Nodal Officer, FCA for making payment of Net Present Value (NPV), Cost of CA, cost of construction of Boundary Pillars and Extraction of the Tree Growth etc., and issue the demand to the User Agency only after vetting by the Nodal Officer.

The conditions proposed in Part II while submitting the processed proposals will be implemented from out of funds deposited under NPV head of CAMPA.

The User Agency will be requested to deposit the compensatory levies towards CA, NPV etc. into the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account of Telangana State, through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., <a href="http://parivesh.nic.in">http://parivesh.nic.in</a> by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-by-step process is available at <a href="http://parivesh.nic.in">http://parivesh.nic.in</a>.

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF & CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013 :

- 1. Publish the entire Forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one is vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
- 2. The copies of the Forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval.
