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It is informed that the Regional Office, MoEF&CC, Government of India, Chennai in the reference 1st cited have accorded In-principle (stage-I) approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 1.95 Ha. of forest land in Sy.No.01/P (compt.No.558) of Elutla RF, Putlur Mandal, Ananthapuram Division & District for extraction of Barytes in favour of Smt. J.C. Vijaya, Tadipatri, Ananthapuram District, subject to conditions stipulated therein. Further, the Government of India stated that after receipt of compliance report on fulfillment of the conditions mentioned therein, the proposal shall be considered for final approval under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

Accordingly, the Conservator of Forests, Ananthapuramu vide reference 4th cited has submitted compliance report.
