Adverting to the subject and reference cited above, it is submitted that, in ref 1st cited, Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, (HoFF), TS, Hyderabad has communicated the Revised Stage-I (inprinciple) approval issued in rf 2nd cited for Regularization of 8.02 Ha of Forest area in Saidulnama RF of Suryapet Division for establishing part of the railway siding and associated activities and other permanent structures in Suryapet District in f/o M/s DCL, Hyderabad for a period of 30 years subject certain conditions stipulated therein and further instructions were issued to submit the demand notice for raising of demand notice to user agency for making payment of compensatory levies in consultation with the Nodal Officer (FCA) and to obtain the compliance report on the conditions stipulated by the Government, from the user Agency and furnish through Conservator of Forests, Khammam for obtaining Stage II (final) approval.

In view of the above, as per the conditions stipulated in the Revised Stage-I approval, the following compensatory levies have to be deposited through the procedure mentioned against each of the component:

Ass per the above, it is submitted that, as per the Revised Stage-I approval the User Agency has to get approval of the Wild Life Mitigation Plan from Chief Wild Life Warden, Telangana State and to submit to this Office for taking further necessary action. In this regard, it is submitted that, the User Agency had submitted an Undertaking stating that, "the Cost for implementation of Wild Life Mitigation Plan will be paid, mean while other Compensatory levies will be paid for taking further necessary action." (Copy enclosed).

Further, the User Agency will be directed to deposit amount as indicated in the table above into respective accounts mentioned against each item. To deposit amount into the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account maintained in the Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003, through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., http://parivesh.nic.in by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-by-step process is available at http://parivesh.nic.in

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF&CC, Gol instructions issued vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013:

- Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one in vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
- The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

The user agency will be requested to comply with the other conditions as directed in ref 3rd and 4th cited and submit the compliance report alongwith all the required relevant information/documents etc. on the conditions stipulated by the Govt. in Stage I approval for obtaining Stage II (final) approval.

The UA will be requested not to carry out any work in violation of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 without receipt of final clearance from the competent authority.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.
