Sub:Forest and Wildlife Department-Proposal for diversion of 0.035 ha of forest land under section 2 Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for electrification of Rosemala area under total electrification scheme-forwarding of -reg.

Ref:1. Letter No.FC2-10559/2017 dated 05.12.2017 from Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (F,L&R)&NO Thiruvananthapuram,Kerala.
2.Letter No. F.No 6-119/2017/WL dated 21.07.2017 from the Ministry of Environment Forests & Climate Change(Wildlife Division), Government of India.

I am to forward herewith 3 hard copies of the proposal along with the required documents duly recommended, for the diversion of 0.035 ha of forest land under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for electrification of Rosemala area, in Schenduruney Wildlife Sanctuary under total electrification scheme, for consideration and approval subject to the following conditions:-

- 1.Legal status of the forest shall remain unchanged.
- 2.The User Agency shall pay Net Present Value as per the guidelines issued by Government of India.
- 3.The User Agency shall give an undertaking to pay additional Net Present Value if required.
- 4.The User Agency shall make online payment of Net Present Value with

ad-hoc CAMPA through e-payment module of forest clearance portal. (forestclearance.nic.in).

5.The User Agency shall not fell any trees other than marked for felling or cause damage to the surrounding forest & shall take all possible measures to conserve tree growth.

6.The User Agency shall not use the forest land for any purpose other than the purpose for which the forest land is diverted.

7.When the forest land is no longer required for the purpose, the land will be resumed back to the Forest Department.


8.The User Agency shall abide by any other condition imposed later on by Government of India/Government of Kerala/Forest Department in the interest of forest conservation.

9.The User Agency shall apply for renewal of approval after 10 years of the date of approval.

10.The User Agency has to sign an agreement with Wildlife Warden, Schenduruney incorporating all the conditions imposed by Government of India/Government of Kerala in this regard and a nominal lease rent as decided by the Government of Kerala may be remitted.

It is informed that as per the letter cited 2nd above that, the Standing Committee of the National Wildlife Board, in the 43rd meeting held on 27.06.2017, recommended the above proposal for laying underground electric cable in the Wildlife Sanctuary. The approval of the Ministry of Environment and Forest may please be communicated to this office at the earliest.
