In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF) Government of India's Lr.No.11-9/98/FC(PT), Dated: 03.08.2009 where in the MoEF issued guidelines in submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act-2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non forest purposes and with MoEF' s Lr. Dated: 05.02.2013 where in MoEF issued certain relaxations in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 8.50 Ha of forest land proposed to be delivered in favour of Dy.E.E, R&B, Bhupalpally for laying of the road from KM 12/2 to 19/6 i.e., from Kishanraopally to Bhupalpally under forest jurisdiction of Bhupalapally Division and belongs to Kishanraopally Village of Malhar Rao mandal in Jayashankar District falls within the Jurisdiction of Bhupalpally Division.

- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required U/s 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabha have given their consent to it.
