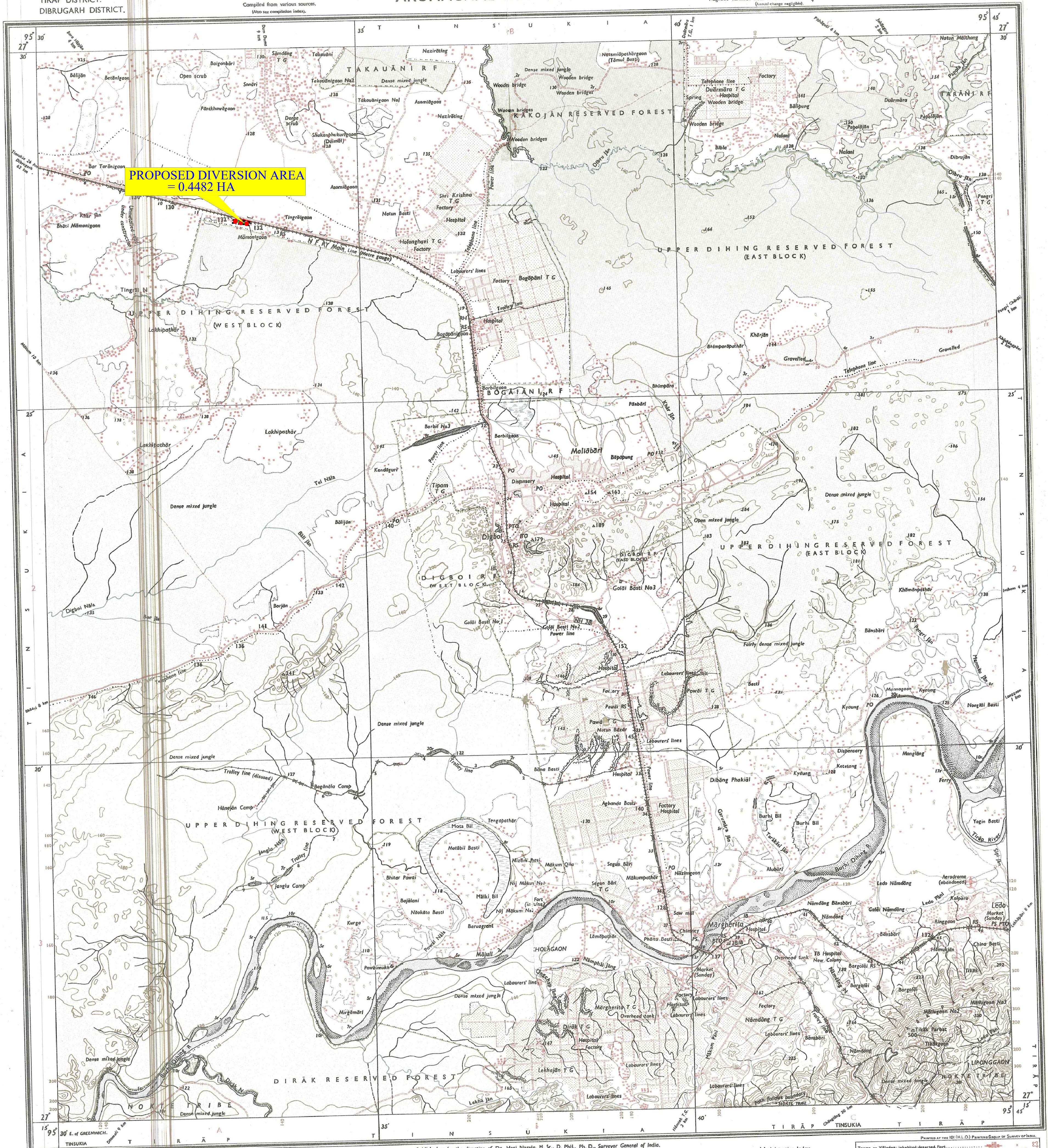

The kilometre stone numbers along the railway and roads are shown in slant type, e.g., '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '5'.

All unmetalled roads inside the Tea Gardens are jeepable throughout the year. Permission to use these roads is required from the Tea Garden authorities.

The sizeable Lakhimpur-Triplichi district boundary, surveyed 1870, based on Gazette Notification, forms the Aranchali Preadah-Astam state boundary. This boundary has not been verified by the Governments concerned.
