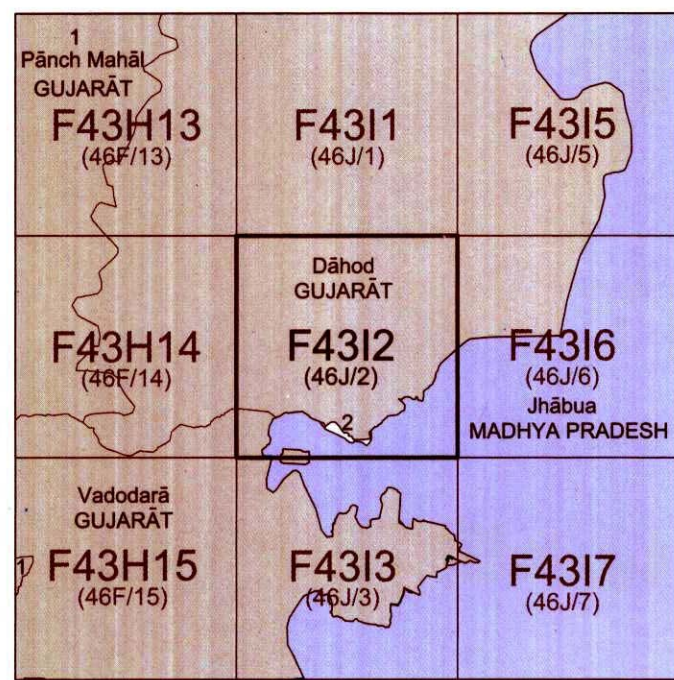

Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet against which there is no descriptive remark are generally passable in dry season.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to February.
The southern boundary of the disputed area in square C16 and D16 has been entered from old 1-inch map 45 372, 1st Edition 1946.
The forest boundaries in Madhya Pradesh have been surveyed as pointed out by the forest officials on the ground but have not been verified by the Forest authorities.
