Accordingly, proposal for following locations is submitted for your perusal and further necessary instructions /action please.

The six locations **DPDA**, **DPDB**, **DPDC**, **DPDE**, **DPDF** & **DPDG** falls under Golaghat Dist. PML. Total area of the granted PML is 52.12 square kilometre and only **2.6123 Ha**. (for drill site area = 160m x 160m = 2.56 Ha. and its Approach road = 0.0523 Ha.) of land is required to accommodate all the six locations for drilling the above locations. The maximum size of each drilling hole is only 18-20 inch. All the locations are planned to drill from a common point which co-ordinates are attached herewith and located the site in Dayalpur village area under Dist. Golaghat .
