TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

Incompliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India letter No11-9/98-FC(pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be delivered for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 0-39.65 Acres, of forest land in Sno 121 of Subramanya village of Sullia Taluk Dakshina Kannada District proposed to be diverted in Favour of Executive Engineer K.R.D.C.L Mysore for the Construction of Bridge across the Kumaradhara river.

It is further certified that:

a) The complete process of identification and settlement of rights under FRA has been carried out for the entirehectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all conclusion and meetings of the Forest Rights committee(s), Gram Sabha, Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexuretoannexure.....(Exempted vide MoEF's Circular ref F. b) the proposal for such diversion (with full details of the projects and its implications, in vernacular/ local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;..... c) each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion . A copy of certificate issued by the Gram

Sabha ofVillage(s) is enclosed as annexure.....

d) the discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50 % of the members of Gram Sabha present;(not applicable)

e) the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;(not applicable)

f) the rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre -Agricultural Committees, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (e) of the FRA.
