JUSTIFICATION FOR ALTERNATIVE ALIGNMENTS (Certificate of Project Authority)

This is to certify Proposal for diversion of 104.427 hectare forest land for the project namely "Widening of existing road from Ambikapur- Ramanuganj Road to improve the efficiency of freight & tourism movement in India [Ambikapur- Ramanuganj Road (117.035 Km)] in the State of Chhattisgarh. The MoRTH alignment partly reserve in Forest land.

Due to increase in traffic and to enhance connectivity the proposed road would act as the prime artery for economic flow to this region. This alignment is chosen as;

- It is the best suitable alignment and design from technical point of view and requiring minimum forest and tree cutting.
