Sub:- (R&B)Dept., - Diversion of 4.98 Hectares of forest land in Karimnagar District – Widening single lane to double lane for the PWD road to Tadicherla from Km.0/0 to 12/7 in Karimnagar District – Submission of proposals – Initiations of land acquisition process – Request – Reg.

It is proposed to take up for Widening single lane to double lane for the PWD road to Tadicherla from Km.0/0 to 12/7 in Karimnagar District. The Government have accorded administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.1500.00 Lakhs vide reference 1st cited.

The length of the road is 12.70 Km single lane with BT surface, it is required to widen by proposing WMM and Bituminous concrete in addition to constructing C.D works, wherever necessary to have proper transportation facilities to the villagers.

The DGPS is carried out for a total length of 4236.99 m and the road is passing through Reserve Forest from Km.0/0 to 3/956, under the forest jurisdiction of Karimnagar East Division. And the reach from Km.3/956 to 4/236(280m), falls in the Non forest area.

The Telangana State Government have taken a policy decision to connect all the Mandal Head Quarters to District Head Quarters to double lane. The Government have accorded administrative sanction for an amount of 15.00 Crores, vide G.O.R.T.No.129 T (R&B) R-II, Dt.27.11.2014. By improving the above road further connectivity in terms of achieving smooth and safe traffic flow with higher level of service. In addition to the above, substantial economic gain in terms of reduced Vehicle Operating Cost (VOC) and reduced travel time will be achieved.

It is proposed to take up road Widening single lane to double lane. As such the permission of the authorities is required. Hence, proposal is submitted for diversion of forest land worked to an extent of 3956m X 12.6 m = 4.98 Hectares in Karimnagar East Division.

A detailed DGPS (Differential Global Position System Survey) is carried out in the above reach along with the forest section officers. As per our requirement the total extent of forest land is arrived as 4.98 Hectares e in the jurisdiction of Karimnagar East Division.

The proposals are submitted as per the guide lines issued under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980, the project for road construction will be processed in their entirety. Hence, the proposals for acquisition of forest land is prepared in the Karimnagar East Forest Division in the prescribed format, drawing showing the improvements, longitudinal section and cross section long with forest map showing area of land are herewith enclosed for king perusal. Hence, I herewith submit the proposals under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 with the following enclosures.

It is, therefore, requested to arrange to initiate the process of forest land acquisition and also required to pass necessary orders to the concerned to start the field survey as early as possible for submitting same to the Government for according approval of linear diversion of forest land for geometrical improvements of road in reserve forest.
