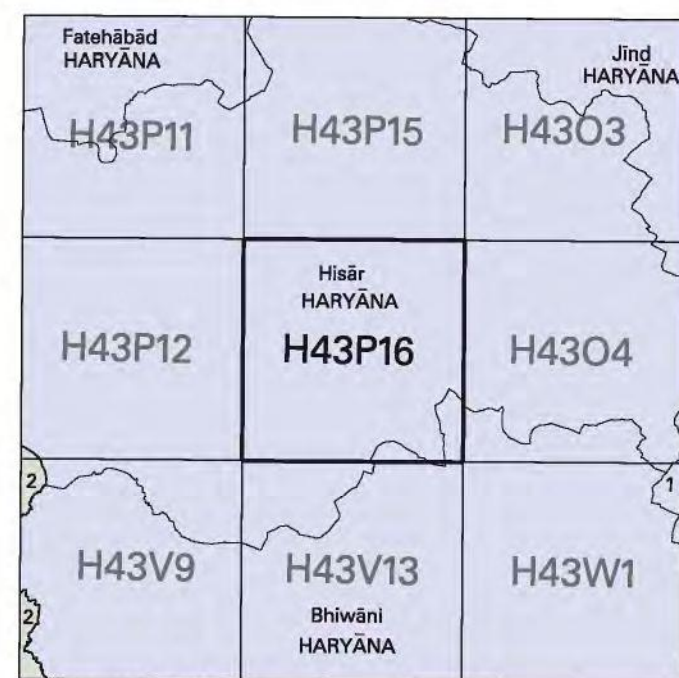

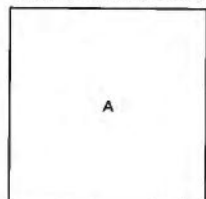

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
 Contours are approximate.
 Important buildings are shown in black with name.
 Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
 Canal distance stones are 1,000 feet apart and every fifth existing stone is shown.
 Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet and only important ones have been shown.
 All cart-roads, and unalluviated roads along canals are motorable throughout the year. Permission to use
 of these is required from the irrigation authorities. Other cart-roads and unalluviated roads are generally
 motorable in dry season.
 A relative height, e.g., R₃, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment
 above the adjacent country.
 10,000-acre reclamation stones of R₁ R₂ R₃ Dam Project surveys based their numbers are shown as
 arbitrary bench — marks thus — $\frac{R^2}{2}$ 185, $\frac{B}{3}$ 212-4.
