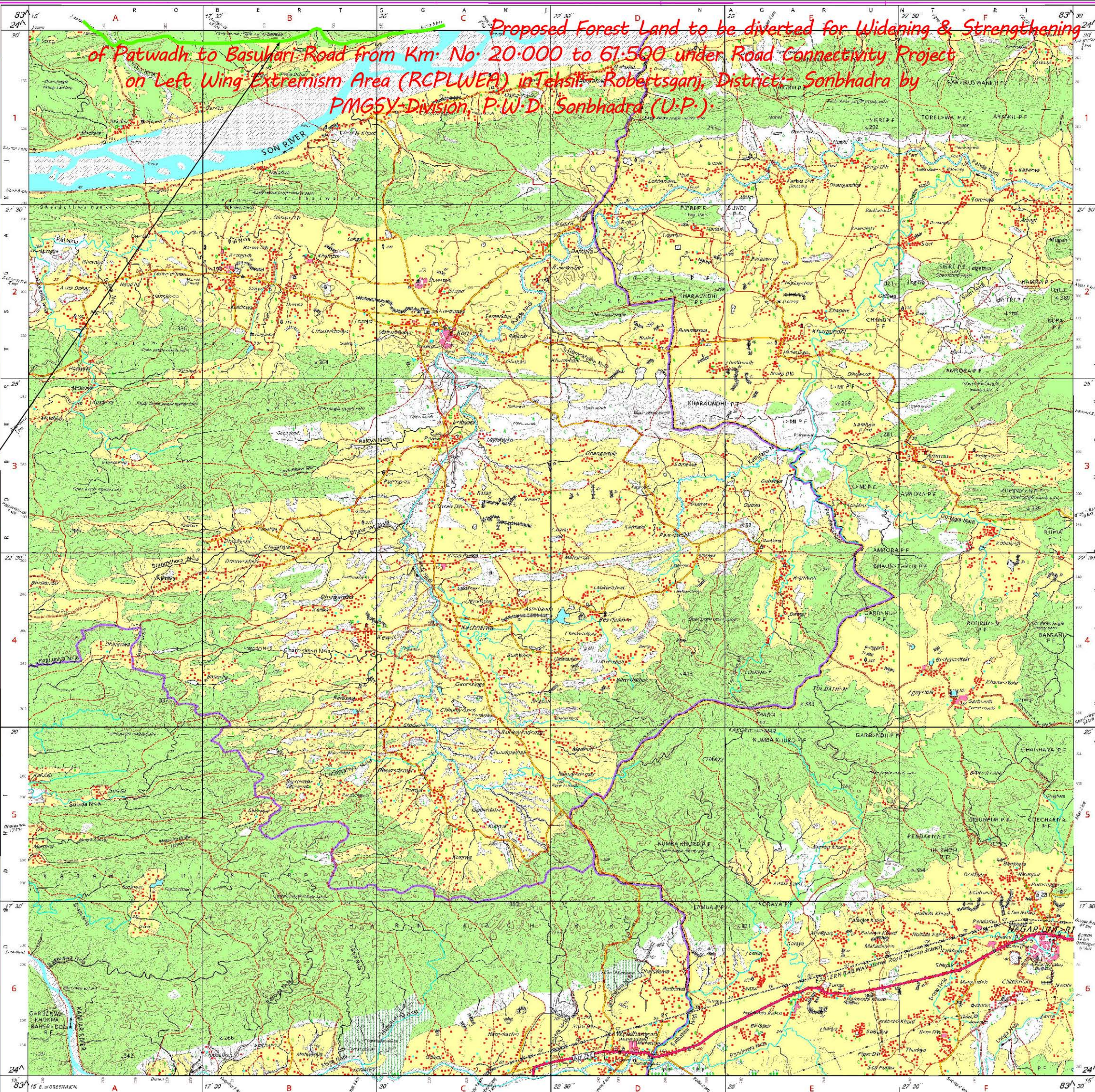

Water features are shown in blue where they generally contain water. Cultivated areas are coloured yellow. The exterior boundaries of towns of Reserved or Protected Forests are shown by green ribbons.

Contours are approximate. A. means height; d.f. represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope. Mountain areas are coloured green. Scattered trees and other vegetation are in green, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.

The kilometre scale numbers along roads and rivers are shown in plain type, e.g., '3' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '31'. Tolls, shown in this area, usually contain water from Jyoti to Patna.

All unmetalled roads are, wherever in dry season. Permission to use these along roads or inside the Reserved Forests is required from the Irrigation and Forest authorities, respectively.

Numerous wells exist throughout the cultivated portions of this sheet, only the important ones have been shown.

Area of special importance by the proposed water of Patna Dam in square 87/3 and 87/4 has been marked by black broken lines.
