In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines and submission of the evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006. ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 10.23 Hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of HIGHWAYS DEPARTMENT for the formation of Chennai Peripheral Road in Kancheepuram District falls within Jurisdiction of Mannur Village, Sriperumbudur Taluk, Thiruthurai Village in Chengalpattu Taluk, Kancheepuram District.
