In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (Pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA, for Short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 2.29 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of ONGC Jorhat (name of the user agency) for location KHDE (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Golaghat district 1 tehsils within jurisdiction of Haldhibari village(s) in Haldhibari Lachit tehsils.

It is further certified that:

- The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 2.29 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure I to iii annexure.....
- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhsa have given their consent to it.
- The proposal does not involve recognised rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural communities.

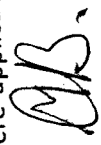
In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (Pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA, for Short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 2.29 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of ONGC Jorhat (name of user agency) for LOCATION KADE (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Solaghat district falls within jurisdiction of Haldibari village(s) in Haldibari tehsils.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 2.29 hectares of the forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure I to III annexure.....
- (b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/ local-language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;
- (c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of / FRC and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate I to annexure IV.
- (d) Haldibari Village is enclosed as annexure I to annexure IV. When there was a discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- (f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (1) of the FRA.
