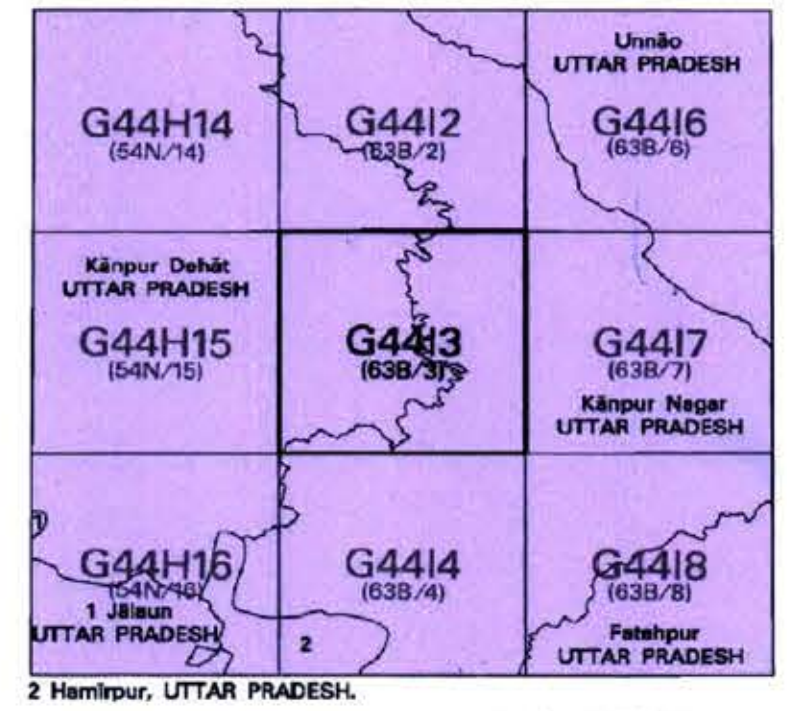

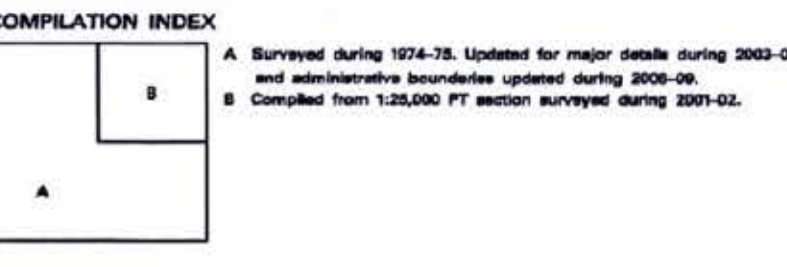

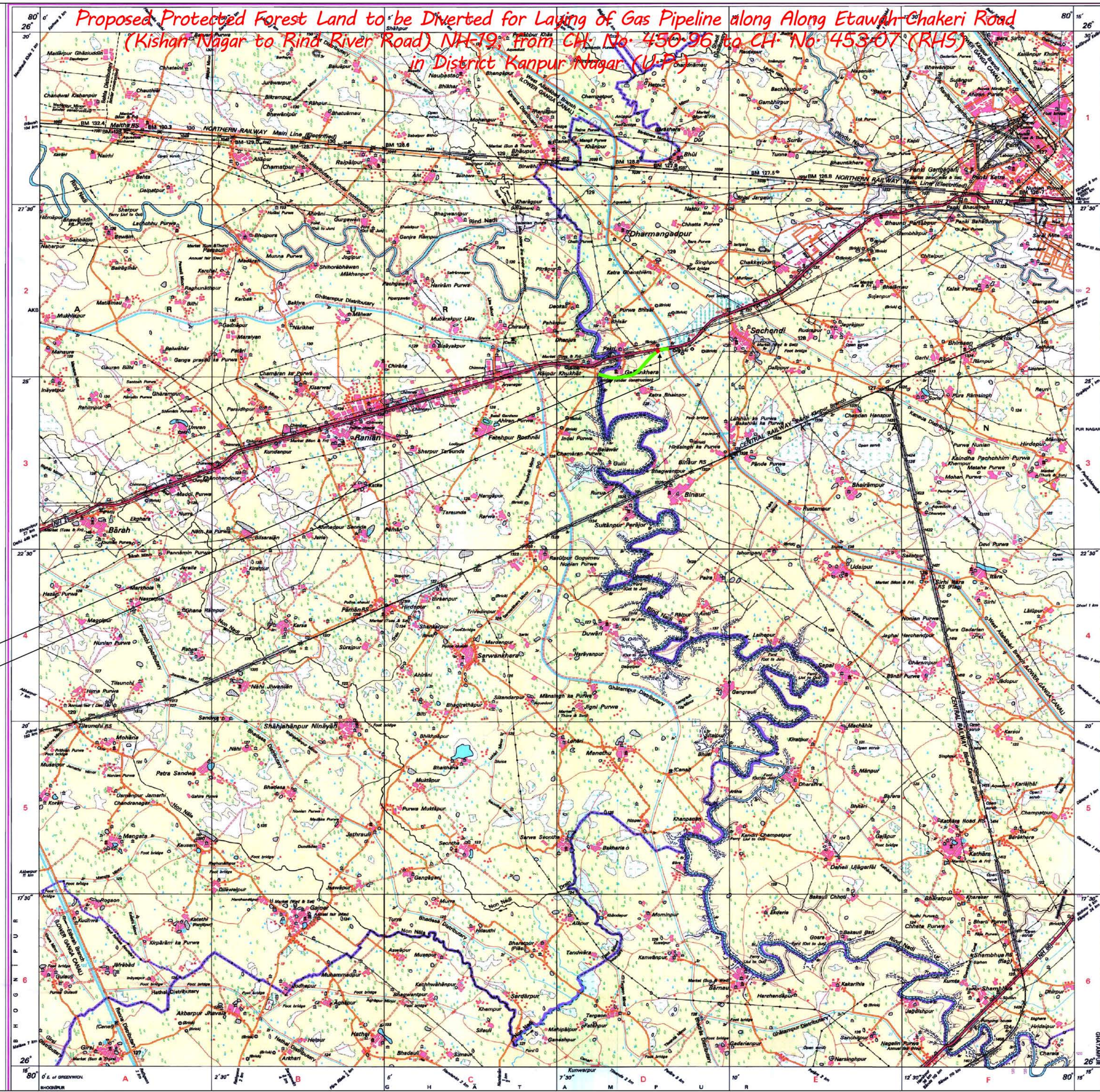

NOTES :-
Heights are in metres and show Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A relative height, e.g., 100, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre scale numbers along roads, railways and canals are shown in short type, e.g., 10, whereas kilometre numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 10.
Towns shown in this area, usually contain water from July to March.
Vegetation is shown throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height, e.g., 100, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Cart-routes and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season.
