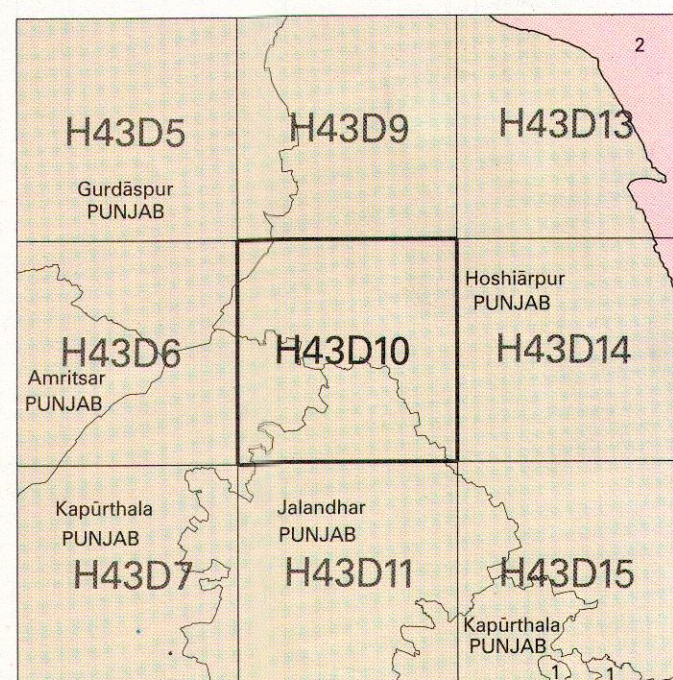

NOTES :-

Permission to use cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.
A relative height e.g., 40, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal bank above the adjacent country.
The area adjoining the Beas River is liable to change owing to continual fluctuation in the course of the river.
Distance shown along protective embankments are 1000 feet apart and every existing lift shown is shown.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height, e.g., 40, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

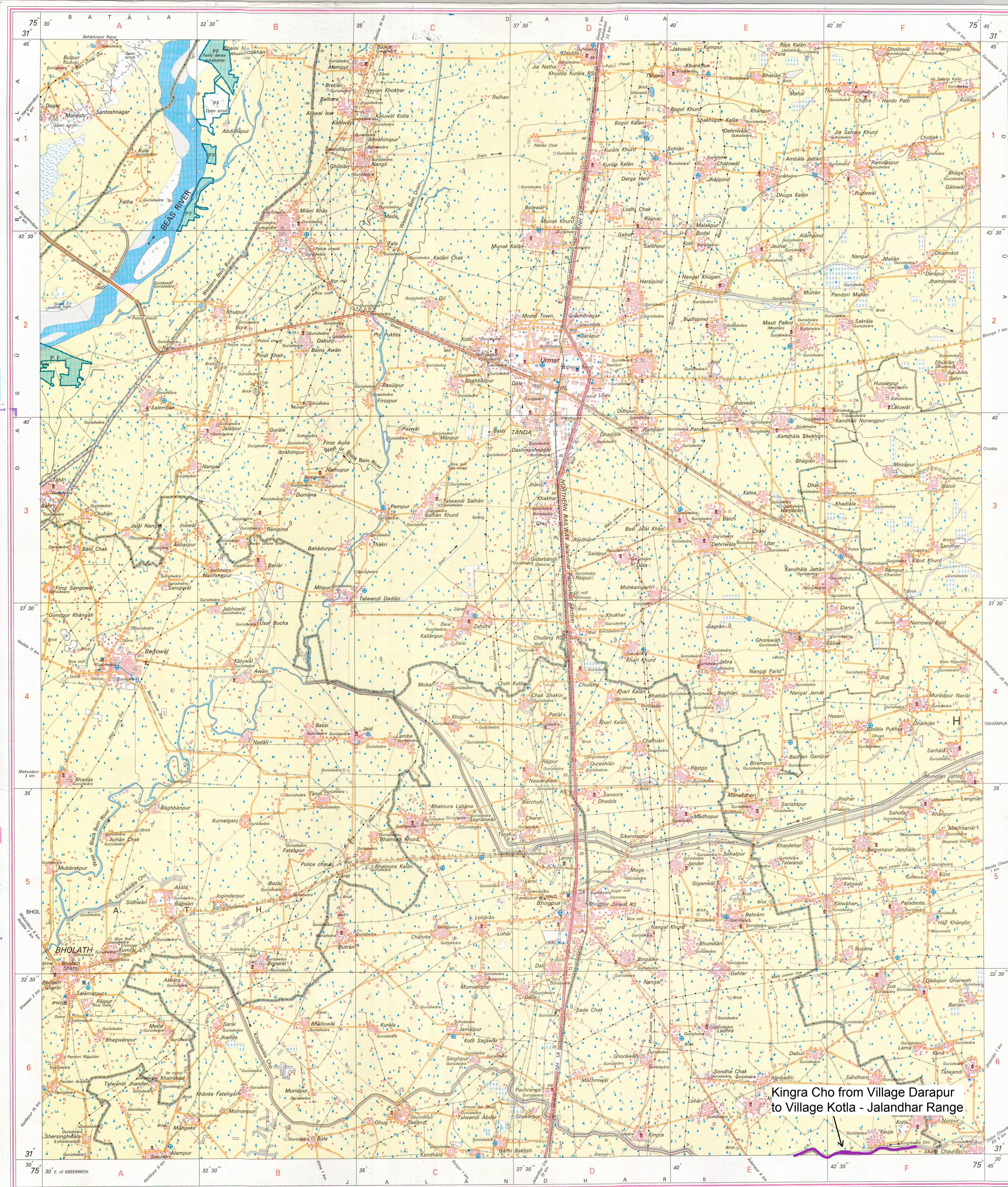
