CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway with toll, with bridge with distance stone
- Roads metalled according to importance
- Roads double cartway, according to importance
- Unmetalled road, Cart-track, Pack-track with pass, Foot-path
- Streams, with track in bed, undefined, Canal
- Dams, masonry or rock-filled, earthwork, Weir
- Rivers dry with water channel, with island & rocks, Tidal river
- Submerged rocks, Shoal, Swam, Reefs
- Wells, lined, unlined, Tube-well, Spring, Tank, perennial, dry
- Embankment, road or rail, tank, Broken ground
- Railways, broad gauge, double, single with station, under construction
- Railways, other gauges, double, single with distance stone, do
- Mineral, line of tramway, Kin, Cutting with tunnel
- Contours, with sub-features, Rocky slopes, Cliffs
- Small features: (1) flat (2) sand-hill (permanent), (3) Dunes (shifting)
- Towns or Villages, inhabited, deserted, Fort
- Hills, permanent, temporary, Tower, Antiquities, Cave, etc.
- Temple, Chhani, Church, Mosque, Idgh, Tomb, Graves, etc.
- Lighthouse, Lightship, Buoys, light, unlight, Anchorage
- Mine, Vine on trail, Grass, Scrub
- Palm, palm, other, Plantain, Conifer, Bamboo, Other trees
- Areas, cultivated, wooded, Surveyed tree
- Boundary, international
- state demarcated, undemarcated
- state demarcated, tribal or lakul forest
- Boundary, Patta surveyed, unlocated, village trijunction
- Heights, triangulated station, point, approximate
- Bench-mark, geodetic, tertiary, canal
- Post office, Telegraph office, Overhead tank
- Rail house or inspection bungalow, Consult house, Police station
- Camping ground, Forest, reserved, protected
- Spacial names, administrative, locality or tribal
- Hospital, Dispensary, Veterinary hospital
- Aerodrome, Helipad, Tourist site
- Power line, with pylons surveyed, with poles unsurveyed

NOTES :-

A relative height e.g. -3' represents the approximate height in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.  
 Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.  
 Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.  
 Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these roads along canals is required from irrigation authorities.  
 Distances shown along canals are 1000 feet apart and every fifth stone is shown.
