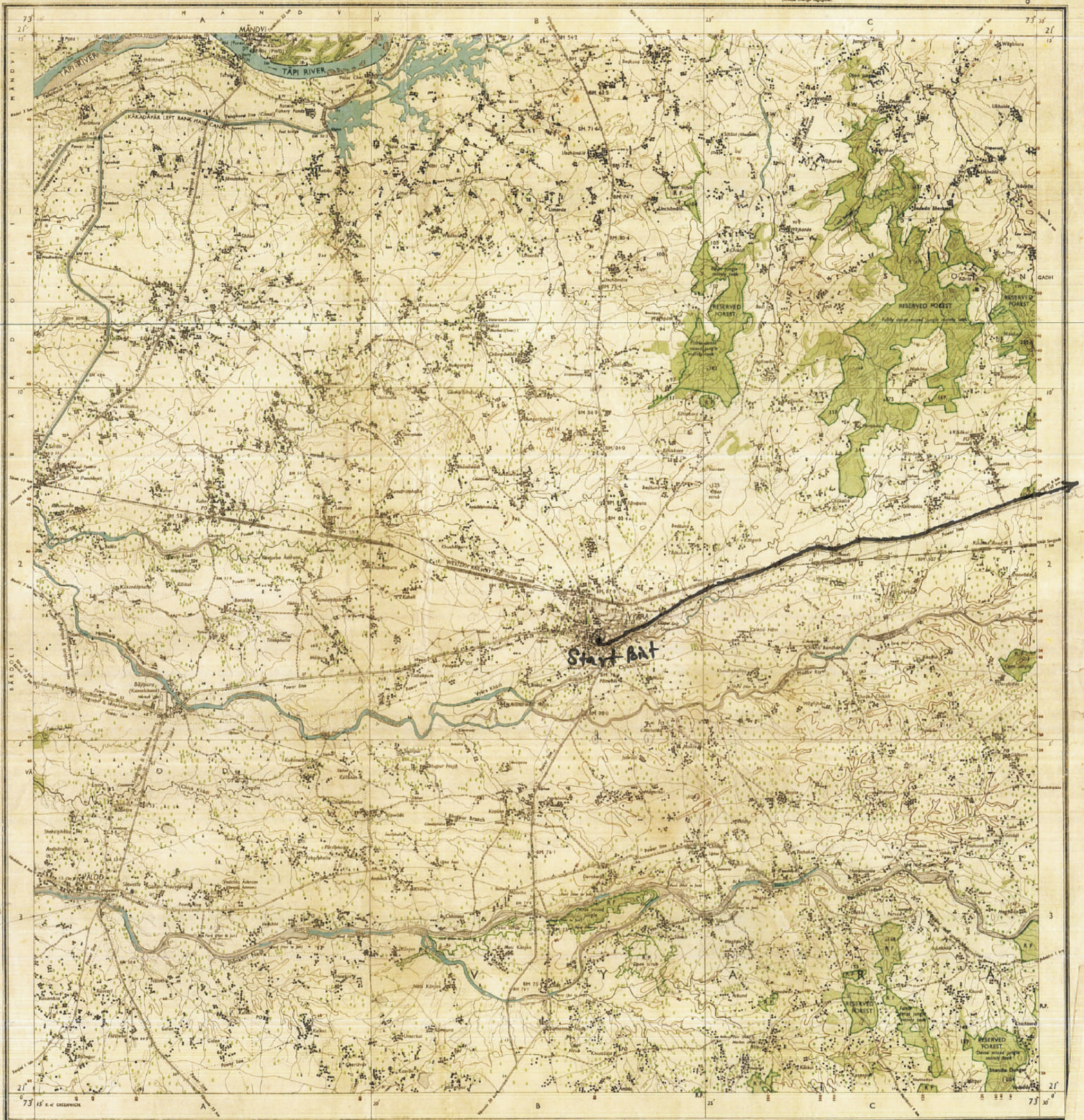

The unshaded heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit levelled bench-marks and may not be exactly in accordance with tide.

A relative height, e.g., 40, marked along a road, indicates the height of the top of the road embankment above the adjacent country.

The kilometre scale numbers along roads, the railway and the canal are shown in dark type, e.g., 10, whereas mile scale numbers are shown in light type, e.g., 10.

Distances shown along the main canal are 1/200 feet apart and every fifth mile is shown.

Unshaded roads along main and branch canal embankments are shown by dashed lines. Permission to use these roads is required from the Irrigation authorities.

Unshaded roads in the sheet are generally metalled in dry season.

Cereals in this sheet are generally sown from July to December.

Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.

Distances are periodic and dependent on rainfall.
