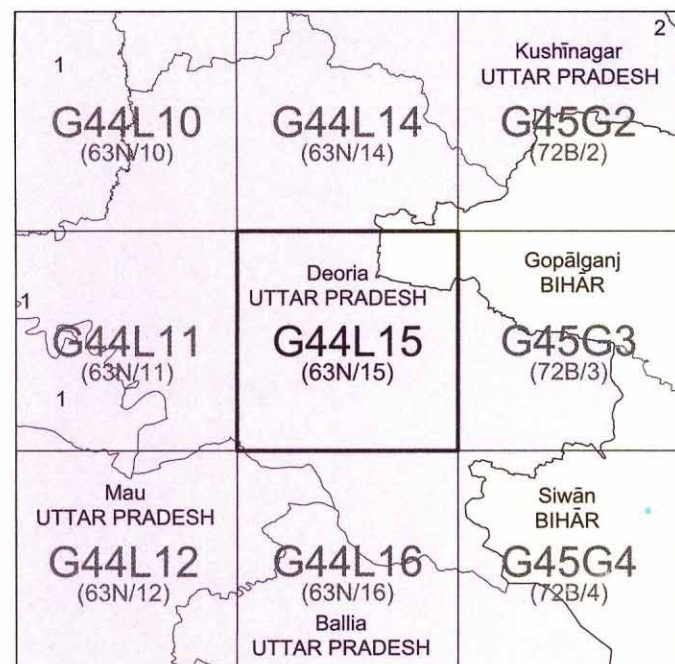

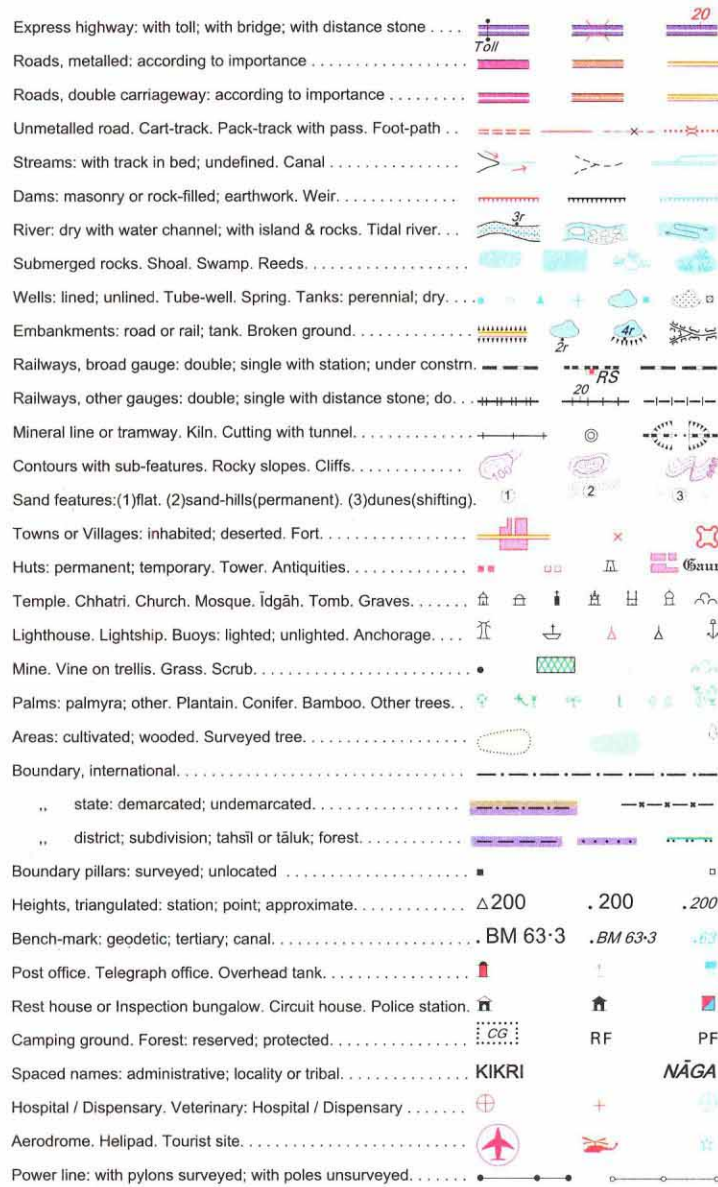

NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.

A relative height, e.g., 40, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre stone numbers along the roads are shown in slant type, e.g., '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '5'.
Tanks, shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to April.
Unrelieved roads and cart tracks in this area are generally motorable in dry season.
Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
The area adjoining the Ghaghara River is liable to change owing to continual fluctuation in the course of the river.
The state boundary between Bihar and Uttar Pradesh States has been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground but has not been verified by the Bihar Government.

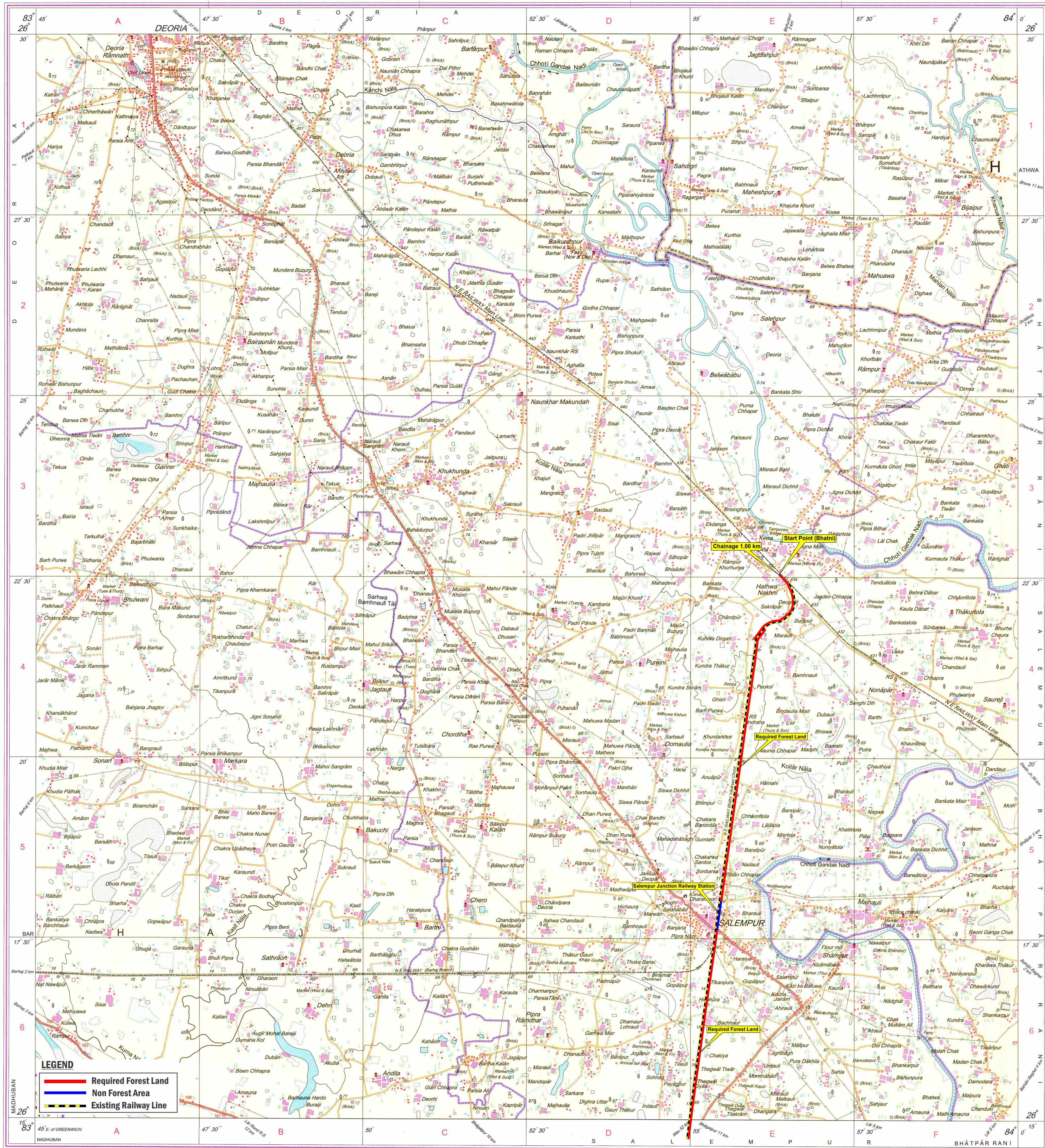
