As hon'ble Prime Minister in his 69th Independence Day speech has announced the Electrification of all balance Un-Electrified Villages (UEV) across country in next 1000 days starting from 16.08.2015. A dedicated scheme is also launched by Govt. Of India namely Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) for electrifying villages on "Mission mode". The Physical progress of electrification of UEVs is periodically monitored by Ministry of Power & Prime Minister's Office.

Proposed Electricity in UE village "Chinki" will provide a safe and efficient energy source for residential and public lighting, pumping drinking water, irrigation, refrigeration, rural industries, and many others. In Umaria District Un-Electrified village "Chinki" situated in between general forest area (in constituency of DFO Umaria) and Buffer Zone of Bandhawgarh Tiger Reserve Forest area. So that the proposed 11 KV line has to cross the forest area for electrification. But Proposed 11 KV line will laid through 11 KV Areal Bunched XLPE overhead Cable and there will no open conductor in 11 KV as well as LT work.
