A relative height, Δ , represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.

Kids are numerous, some have been omitted to bring out their relative distribution.

Unmetalled roads, against which there is no remark and most of the cart-tracks are jeepable in dry season.

The area shown on this map is magnetically disturbed and the variation given may differ largely from the actual value.
