I. (a) Procedure for e-challan generation:

- On issue of this demand notice, the user agency shall log into Forest clearance portal forestclearance.nic.in to generate e-challan and make payment against this demand.
- ii. Agency shall fill all the details as per the format provided in the portal and submit to Nodal Officer for verification.
- iii. Once it is verified by Nodal Officer, Agency can generate e challan from the portal.

I (b) Procedure for payment through RTGS:

- iv. For payment through RTGS, the representative of the agency should visit his bank branch (RTGS enabled) of a Bank of his choice along with printed e-challan with an Account number printed on it.
- v. While tendering the e-challan at the bank, the agency must ensure that the unique account number mentioned in the challan should be correctly mentioned as the account number in which funds to be remitted.
- vi. Upon executing the RTGs by the sender / remitter bank, the amount collected will be credited to relevant CAMPA state account with the Bank on real time basis.
- II. Amount demanded for Tree extraction logging and transportation in the Forest area diverted to be deposited with Divisional Forest Officer (As per IGF, Adhoc CAMPA Lr.No.13-20/2015-CAMPA, dated: 09.06.2016 communicated vide PCCF's Rc.No.45921/2001/FCA-4 (iii), dated: 04.07.2016).

Further, it is informed that if any payment is made by any other method, the same shall not be considered for compliance towards stage-II as per the guidelines issued in the 1st cited.

The Executive Engineer, Panchayat Raj, Vizianagaram is requested to furnish the remittance particulars of Net Present Value as stated above to this office along with condition wise compliance report for the Stage-I approval invariably to this office and also submit in PARIVESH portal too.

The user agency is also requested to comply with the following conditions in accordance with the Government of India instructions issued in F.No.7-23/2012-FC, dt: 24.07.2013 communicated in PCCF Rc.No.45921/2001-F4, dt: 23.08.2013 and publish the orders at the cost of the project proponent.

- Publish the entire Forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and another in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of Forest land for non-forestry purposes.
- 2. The copies of the Forest clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn have to display the same for 30 days.
