SUBJECT;- Grant of Mining Lease in the district of Cuttack.

READ:- Application presented on 18.4.1964 by M/s Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd, for grant of a Mining Lease for Iron ore over an area of 7 Sq. miles or 1812.6080 hectares in Talpada (Daitari) in the district of Cuttack.

O R D E R:-

Whereas M/s Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd, have applied to the State Government in accordance with the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 for grant of a Mining Lease by their application read above;

Whereas the mineral in the land in respect of which the mining lease has been applied for belongs to Government and the land is at their disposal;

Whereas the applicant holds a valid certificate of approval from the State Government;

Whereas the applicant being a limited company is incorporated registered in India;

Whereas the Central Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to section 6(1) of the Mines and Minerals ( Regulation and Development ) Act, 1957, have permitted M/s Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd, in the interest of mineral development to acquire mining lease for Iron ore over an area of 7 Sq. miles in Talpada (Daitari) in the district of Cuttack in excess of the maximum limit prescribed in section 6(1) (b) thereof

Whereas the Government of India have conveyed their approval to the grant of M.L. under Section 5(2) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation & Development) Act, 1957 and also in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 30 of the said Act, directed the State Government to take into consideration this application and pass orders thereon not later than 31.5.1965.

Whereas the party were asked in Mining and Geology Department letter No. 1689-MG, dated 26.2.1965 to indicate their acceptance of the terms and conditions under which the mining lease was proposed to be considered for grant and the party their letter No. 10730/OMC/64 dated 4.3.1965 accepted these conditions

And wherea's the State Government are hereby pleased to order that a Mining Lease in respect of the land applied for be granted to Messrs. Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd, subject to the conditions laid down in the State Government letter No. 1689-MG, dated 26.2.1965. The party should comply with all the terms and conditions including furnishing of a surveyed map and declaration within 3 months from the date of this order to the Collector, Cuttack.
