



FULL JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING THE PROJECT IN FOREST AREA
(UN-AVOIDANCE OF THE FOREST AREA FOR THE PURPOSE)

Annasagar - Pitlam is identified as Major District road. The road starts at Km.128/6 near Boggugudise, on Hyderabad-Medak-Bodhan road which is identified as one of the high density traffic corridor under Core Net Roads, and ends on National Highway - 161 at Km. 86/4, having a total length of 10.50 kilometres. The existing road width is Double lane from Km. 0/0 to 3/8, Single Lane from Km.3/8 to 10/500. The entire road is having Block topped surface. This road is being used by the people from mandals Viz., Pitlam, Nizamsagar, Yellareddy, Shankrampet for going to Nizamabad District head quarters and Hyderabad, because the National Highway is at 10.50 Kilometres away, which is an easy access and time saving. This road is having connectivity for interstate transportation to Maharashtra and Karnataka states, due to shortest route.

There is a tourist spot at Nizamsagar project at km.3/8 and many tourists using to visit on public holidays.

The reach of Annasagar to Pitlam road from Km.6/260 to 6/730 Right side, 6/730 to 6/830 Right side, 6/830 to 6/920 Both sides, 6/920 to 7/380 Left side, 7/380 to 10/400 Both sides is under the Forest Jurisdiction of Nizamabad Division. The Telangana state Government have taken policy decision to improve the roads from Single lane to Double lane connecting from Mandal headquarter to District head quarters. After improvements of this road, it will provide good connectivity to Nizamabad District head quarter in addition to Karnataka and Maharashtra states for the people coming from four districts Viz., Hyderabad, Ranga Reddy, Medak & Karimnagar. There by a considerable saving in time and fuel. Hence it is very much vital to widen the road to smooth flow of traffic.
