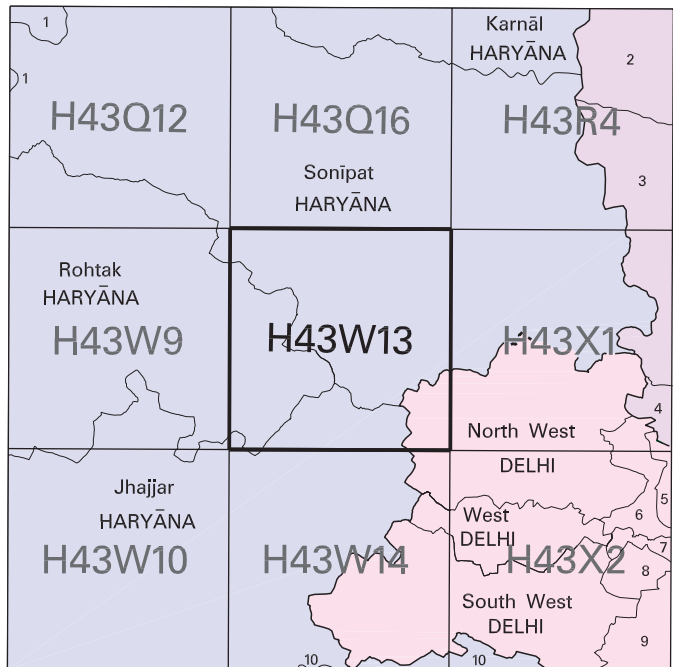

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height e.g., 3m, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Unmetalled roads and cart-roads in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from irrigation authorities.

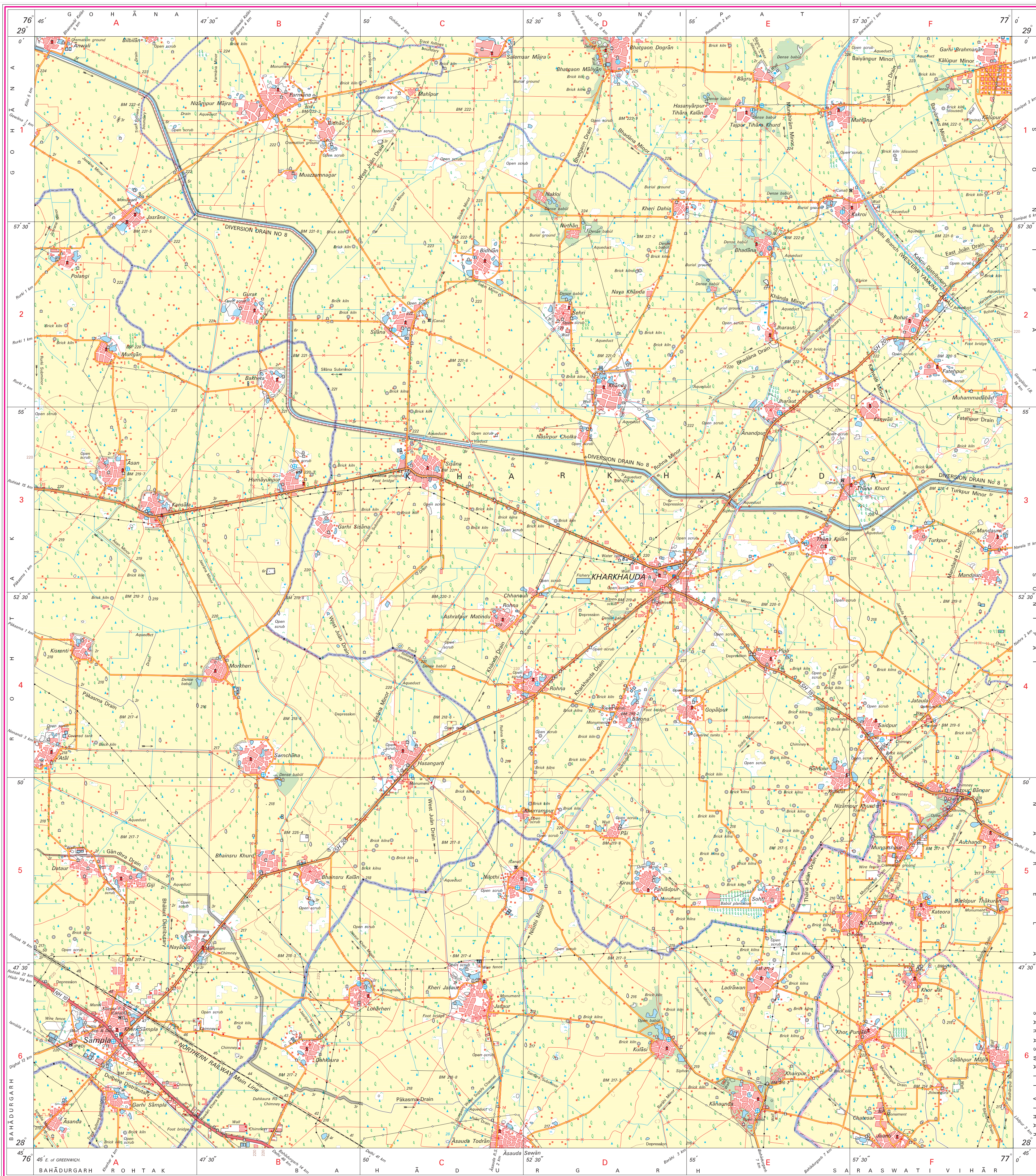
