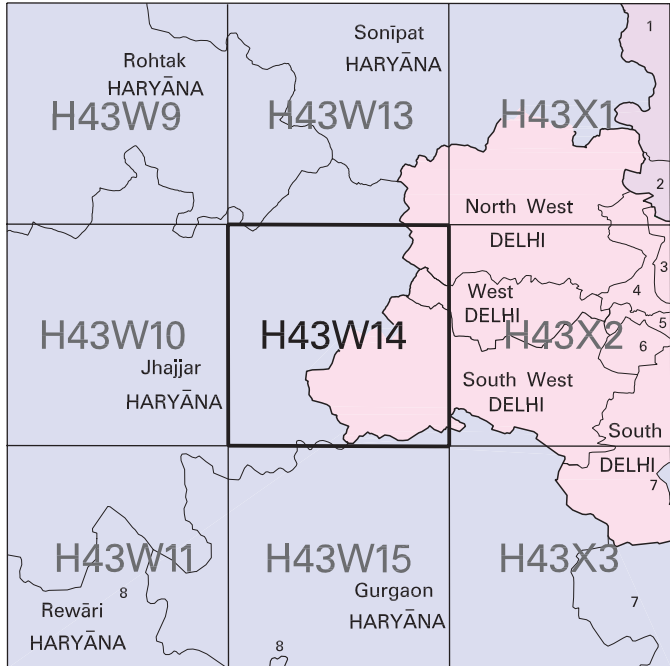

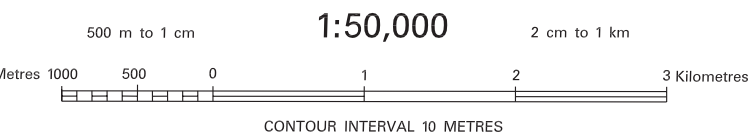
Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
Important buildings are shown in black with names.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height e.g., 3r, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
Distance stone along Duhra Districtary and Jahangipur Minor are 1000 feet apart and every 5th existing stone is shown.
A relative height, 3r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

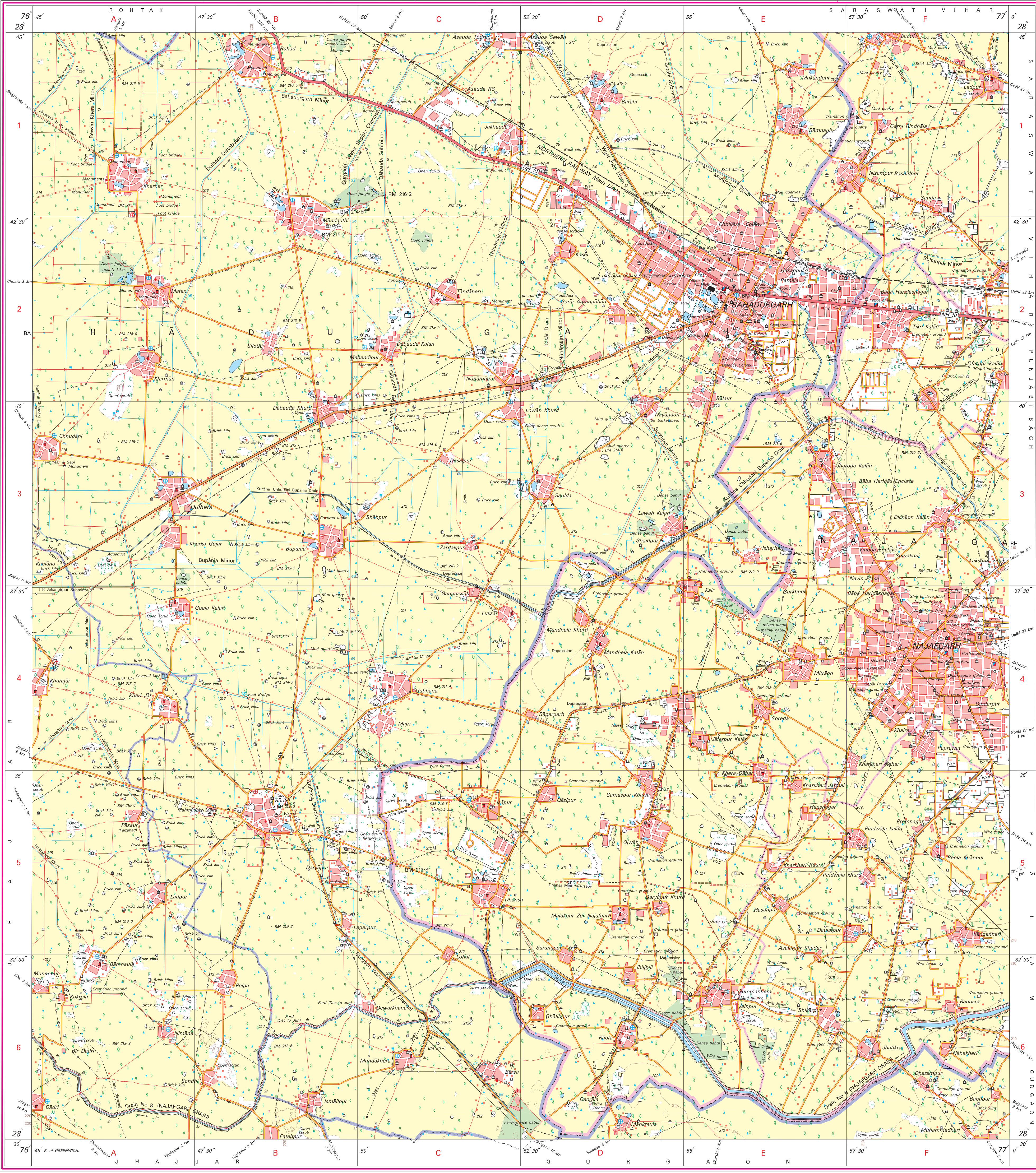
