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CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway: with cut, with bridge, with distance stone
- Roads, metalled, according to importance
- Roads, double carriageway, according to importance
- Unmetalled road: Cart track, Pack-track with gear, Foot-path
- Stream: with bank in front, unfilled Canal
- Dam: masonry or rock-filled, with crest, Over
- River: dry with water channel, with island & rocks, Tide river
- Submerged river: Strait, Swamp, Reefs
- Water: level, unfilled, Tube-well, Spring, Tanka, permanent, dry
- Embankment: road or rail, bank, Broken ground
- Railways, broad gauge: double, single with station, under construction
- Railways, other gauges: double, single with distance stone, 4 ft.
- Mineral line or tramway: Rick, Cutting with tunnel
- Contours with sub-features: Rocky slopes, Cliff
- Sand features: (Hills, dunes, ridges, spurs, etc.) (Shaded, hatched)
- Towns or Villages: inhabited, deserted, Fort
- Hut: permanent, temporary, Tower, Antiquities
- Temple, Chhatra, Church, Mosque, Ghat, Tank, Ganga
- Lighthouse, Lightship, Buoy: lighted, unlighted, Anchorage
- Mine: live on strike, Grass, Birch
- Panor: primary, other, Panor, Conifer, Bamboo, Other trees
- Area: cultivated, wooded, Surveyed tree
- Boundary: international
- Water: dammed, unfilled, with island & rocks
- Electric: substation, aerial or other, tower
- Pillar: surveyed, uncoloured, village, boundary
- Height: triangulated, station, point, approximate
- Bench-mark: geodetic, levelling, canal
- Post office: Telegraph office, Overhead tank
- Rail: station or inspection bungalow, Circuit house, Police station
- Camping ground: Forest: reserved, protected
- Survey names: administrative, locality or tribal
- Hospital, Dispensary, Veterinary hospital
- Aerodrome, heliport, Tourist site
- Power line: with poles surveyed, with poles unsurveyed

NOTES

- Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
- Contours are approximate.
- Important buildings are shown in black with names.
- Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
- Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
- Unmetalled roads and cart-roads in this sheet are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these along roads is required from the irrigation authorities.
- Canal distance shown on 1:50,000 scale and every existing tank shown in this sheet is shown in black.
- A station height (e.g., 100) represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a sheet.
- 5,000 are contour interval shown of Indian Mean Sea Level. Surveyed with their numbers are shown in black.
