
TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

The Kanakkampalayam Tank scheme is proposed near Kanakkampalayam Village in Gobichettipalayam Taluk of Erode District. On executing this scheme, nearly 500 acres of additional land will get irrigated directly and nearly 1500 acres of land will get irrigated indirectly. Ground Water Level will raise, will improve Drinking water Facilities, Cattle feed facilities which in turn will increase the economy of the people residing in that area. This Scheme ultimately increases the basic needs, improves the Agriculture and other related employment activities which in turn improves Socio-Economic status of the nearly 22,000 people living in the foot of hills in Kanakkampalayam, Perumugai and Kondayampalayam village.

This scheme involves acquisition of 88.46 acres of Guttiyalathur Reserve Forest Land and 14.30 acres of Patta Land in Kanakkampalayam Village. The project area does not involve the migration of the Scheduled Tribes and other traditional Forest dwellers.

The Compensatory land of 73.00.0 Hectare (180.30 Acre) Government barren land was identified in S.F.No.2144/2017 of Bargur 'A' Village in Anthiyur Taluk of Erode District. Regarding this, based on the report obtained from the Tahsildar of Anthiyur Taluk, the site was inspected on 15.04.2015 by the Sub Collector, Gobichettipalayam. In his inspection report, he had stated that the identified poromboke land in S.F.No. 2144/2017 of Bargur 'A' village in Anthiyur taluk is a clear barren land and Boundary stones were laid around the land. This land is eligible for afforestation and it is proposed to handing over to the Forest Department.

Hence it is recommended that there is no objection for acquiring 88.46 acres of reserve forest land for the proposed project and also handing over the Compensatory land of 73.00.0 Hectare (180.30 acres) Government barren land to the Forest Department.
