 A relative height, e.g., ± 20 , marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
 Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
 Tides, shown on the coast, are the mean high water of the tide, and the lowest water level has been shown.
 Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks along canal embankments are noticeable in dry season. Permission to use these is required from the irrigation authorities.
