Adverting to the subject and references cited, it is to inform that Government of India, Ministry of Environment , Forests & Climate change, New Delhi vide reference 1st cited has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of **3168.1315 Ha(revised from 3221.2974 ha)** of Forest Land in 8 different Forest Divisions viz. Mahadevpur, Karimnagar, Sircilla, Siddipet, Yadadri, Medak, Nizamabad, Banswada and Nirmal forest Divisions for construction of canals, tunnels, lift system, surge pool, delivery cistern and reservoirs etc., involved in Kaleshwaram Project in favour of Chief Engineer, Kaleshwaram project under TDWSP, TS, Hyderabad, subject to the compliance of the certain conditions mentioned therein, which has been communicated to the Chief Engineer, Kaleswaram project vide ref 2nd cited.

The demand notices for payment of various Compensatory levies have been served by the concerned District Forest Officers/ Forest Divisional Officers in the references 4th to 17th cited to the Chief Engineer, Kaleshwaram project, as per the conditions stipulated. The consolidated demand details, for making the necessary

payment into the accounts indicated is given below:

The User Agency has to deposit an amount of **Rs.704,37,61,779/-** (Rupees Seven hundred and four Crore, thirty seven lakh, sixty one thousand , seven hundred and seventy nine only) through online mode only in the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account maintained in the Corporation

Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road New Delhi-110003.

The payment has to be made through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., forestsclearance.nic.in by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department.

The User Agency has to deposit an amount of **Rs. 17,92,56,297/- (Rupees Seventeen Crore, ninety two lakh, fifty six thousand, two hundred and ninety seven only)into the respective PD Accounts of DFOs/ FDOs** as given in the demands issued vide references 4th to 17th above.

The User Agency shall undertake afforestation along the periphery of the reservoirs and canals for which the scheme is enclosed for an amount of **Rs19,21,58,298/- (Rupees Nineteen Crore, twenty one lakh, fifty eight thousand, two hundred and ninety eight only)** for implementation by the User Agency. The User Agency shall submit an undertaking to this effect in the compliance report.

Further, the Chief Engineer, Kaleshwaram project, TS, Hyderabad is also requested to make payment of Rs.11,17,664/-(Rupees Eleven lakh, seventeen thousand six hundred and sixty four only) towards loss of 14034 Eucalyptus trees under submergence of Konda Pochamma sagar in Siddipet Division as communicated in reference 18th cited above (copy enclosed), in consultation with VC & MD, TSFDC.

Further the Chief Engineer, Kaleshwaram project, TS, Hyderabad is also requested to intimate the details of payments made and submit seven sets of compliance report on all the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval along with all the necessary documents, certificates, undertakings etc for onward submission to the competent authority for issual of Stage II approval.

Transfer of Forest Land proposed for diversion to the User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval. The in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of (5) years. In the event of non-compliance of the conditions, the in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.
