JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING THE PROJECT ON FOREST LAND

The Optical Fiber Cable is generally laid along the admitted RoW of State/National Highway

roads. Such roadside area is declared as the Protected Forest under the Indian Forest Act.

The area requested for laying of the Optical Fiber Cable is the bare minimum considering the

requirements and considering the safety of the cables so laid. Since the telecommunication

cables also carry the communication from the Government offices, Defense & Strategic

establishments, and from different industrial organizations apart from the public, for the

safety and confidentiality of the conversation so made, it is not advisable to lay such

important cables on the private land belonging to different parties.

The Cable alignment will be suitably diverted to avoid any cutting of trees and laid within

the road land boundary by excavating a narrow trench of 45 cms. width. The same strip of

trench will be reinstated to its original condition. It is also intimated that no structure will be

erected on the cable route.
