
2. In this context, it is intimated that the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has conveyed "*in-principle*" approval under the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for the diversion of forest land on the subject cited land diversion case. You are, therefore, requested to go through the stipulations imposed by the Govt. on the approval and take appropriate action on the issues pertains to your office/user agency. As already mentioned in the approval in question that the Govt. has developed an e-payment module forest clearance portal for online remittance of the amount under Net Present Value component . Therefore, the payments towards above component shall be deposited online through the e-payment portal such as online Challan mode in Ad-hoc CAMPA:- The component wise detail of amount and mode of deposition is as under:-
