

Note containing justification for locating the Project in forest land

Madhya Pradesh Jal Nigam Maryadit a government of Madhya Pradesh undertaking is incorporated as a wholly owned State Government company , which is formed in the Year 2012 under the Companies Act 1956, with the vision and aim to provide safe and tap drinking water to communities and raw water to industries by utilizing surface water resources and to provide sustainable treatment and disposal of sewage, with a mission to transform themselves in to a public friendly institution for providing drinking water and sewage services at the door step.

In this connection a Bandol Multi Village Rural Water Supply Scheme has framed up taking back water of Bheemgarh dam on Wainganga river as a source, near village Gohana of block Chhapara, District Seoni (M.P.), which includes about 208 villages in the vicinity (Seoni and Chhapara block). Water Treatment Plant is proposed in village Suwakheda and clear water rising main pipe line is proposed to fetch water up to these villages through 3 Intermediate Pumping Stations and 131 over Head Service Reservoirs. For the execution of aforesaid Drinking Water Supply Scheme the work has been awarded to M/s Larsen & Toubro Ltd. Chennai.
