TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC(Pt) dt.3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers( Recognition of Forest Rights Act), 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February'2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.625 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of M/s Jindal Power & Steel Ltd. for laying of slurry pipe line in Keonjhar District falls within jurisdiction of Tahakurani R.F.(0.100Ha.), Baitarani R.F.(0.187Ha.), Jalahari village(0.006 Ha.), Jajanga village(0.029 Ha.) and Badakalimati village(0.037 Ha.) under Barbil Tahasil, Taramakanta village(0.177 Ha.) Kusukala village(0.031 Ha.) and Taramakanta R.F.(0.024 Ha.) under Banspal Tahasil and Nayagarh village(0.034 Ha.) under Jhumpura Tahasil.

It is further certified that

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.625 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion
- (b) No such facilities managed by Government requiring diversion of forest land u/s 3(2) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006 exist over the forest land proposed for diversion
- (c) the proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities.



In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribe and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 1.518 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **Jindal Steel & Power Ltd.** for **laying of slurry Pipeline** in Angul district falls within jurisdiction of Kantala, Dalo, Rugudidiha, Banar, Muktapur, Nagira, Balibahal, & Durgapur villages in Pallahara and Angul tehsil.

It is further certified that :

- (a) the complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 1.518 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion.
