Figure 1. The effect of the concentration of the monomer on the polymerization of α -methylstyrene initiated by BuLi in THF at -78°C . The reaction was carried out in the presence of BuLi (0.01 mol/L) and THF (10 mL) for 10 min. The concentration of the monomer was 0.1, 0.2, 0.3, 0.4, 0.5, 0.6, 0.7, 0.8, 0.9, and 1.0 mol/L. The polymerization was stopped by the addition of methanol. The polymer was isolated by precipitation into methanol. The polymer was dried under vacuum at 40°C for 24 h. The polymer was then weighed and the yield was calculated. The polymerization was carried out in the presence of BuLi (0.01 mol/L) and THF (10 mL) for 10 min. The concentration of the monomer was 0.1, 0.2, 0.3, 0.4, 0.5, 0.6, 0.7, 0.8, 0.9, and 1.0 mol/L. The polymerization was stopped by the addition of methanol. The polymer was isolated by precipitation into methanol. The polymer was dried under vacuum at 40°C for 24 h. The polymer was then weighed and the yield was calculated.

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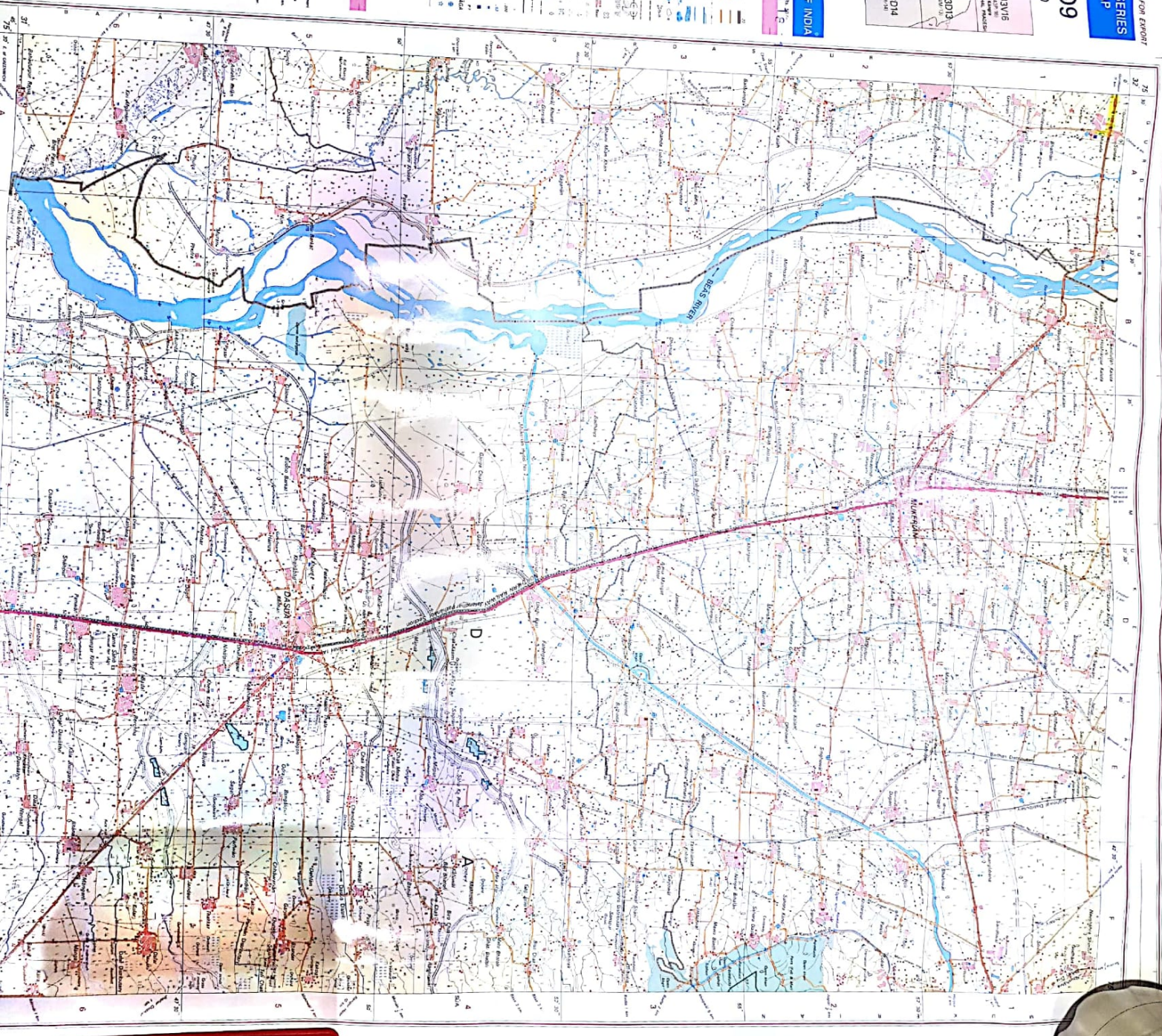
