Contours are approximate

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level

A relative height, e.g., 200, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope

The Victoria street numbers, along roads and the railway are shown in black type, e.g., 1, whereas milestone numbers are shown in light type, e.g., 10

Tracks, shown in black, in the area, usually contain water from July to December

The major administrative boundaries of districts in Andhra Pradesh State are called 'Mandals' and their boundaries are shown by black boundary symbol
