Note: The transmission line has been divided into 3 Packages to ensure the timely completion of the project.

The aforesaid transmission line shall be constructed by REC Power Development Consultancy Ltd (RECPDCL, a 100% subsidiary of REC Limited, a Navratna CPSU under Ministry of Power) on behalf of Ladakh Power Development Department (LPDD).

The envisaged benefits under the projectare as follows:

- 1. Act as a catalyst in the socio-economic development of Zanskar valley.
- 2. Strategic in nature and will provide grid connectivity to the border areas.
- 3. Ensure power evacuation from upcoming hydroelectric projects.
- 4. Link far-flung villages to the Grid and phase out DG sets, thus take one more step towards achieving Carbon Neutrality in Ladakh.
- 5. Ensure 24x7 grid-connected power supply as compared to present 7-8hours of power supply through DG sets.

The route for the aforesaid transmission line has been finalized out of three alternative routes based on their feasibility of the route and after careful study and various site visits by the officials of RECPDCL, LPDD and DGRE.

The efforts have been made to avoid forest as far as possible resulting which out of 661 tower locations only 35 no. of tower locations were found in the notified forest land during e-route survey conducted with the Divisional Forest Officer, Kargil on 03rd Dec, 2021. The locations where it is absolutely unavoidable, the efforts were made to adopt such a route of transmission line which involves minimum felling/trimming/prunning of trees and use of such land will

be done only after clearance from the concerned competent authority.
