Heights and contours have not been shown.
A relative height, Δ , represents the approximate height in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre stone numbers along the railways, roads and canals shown in slant type, e.g., 5, whereas milestone numbers along canals are shown in upright type, e.g., 5.
Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally mettable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals and the Reserved Forest areas is required from irrigation and Forest authorities respectively.
Wells & tube wells are numerous through out the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
Tanks, shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to April.
A relative height, e.g., 70, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Administrative names and boundaries in this sheet have been shown as per present political set-up after formation of Uttarakhnad state.
