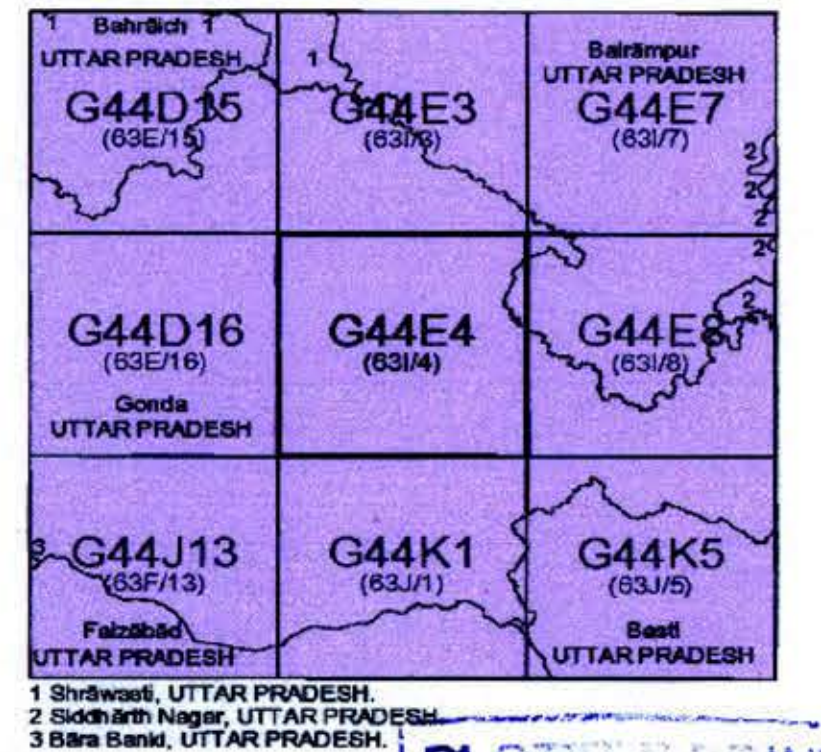

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- CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS**
- Express highway with toll, with bridge, with distance stone
 - Road, metalled, according to importance
 - Road, double carriageway, according to importance
 - Unmetalled road. Cart track. Back track with pass. Foot path.
 - Stream, with back in bed, unbridged. Canal
 - Dam, masonry or rock-filled, with lock. Tidal river
 - Submerged road. Canal. Swamp. Ponds.
 - Water, lined, unlined. Tube well. Spring. Tanks. Panjiri. etc.
 - Embankment: road or rail. Sink. Broken ground
 - Railway, broad gauge: double, single with station, under construction
 - Railway, meter gauge: double, single with station, under construction
 - Mineral line or railway. Km. Cutting with tunnel
 - Contours with sub-features. Rocky slopes. Cliffs
 - Sand features (1/16th, 1/32nd, 1/64th, 1/128th)
 - Towns or Villages: inhabited, deserted, Fort
 - Hut: permanent, temporary. Tower. Antiquities
 - Temple. Chhatri. Church. Mosque. Ghat. Tomb. Shrine
 - Lighthouse. Lightship. Buoy. Lighted, unlighted. Anchorage
 - Mine. View on traffic. Glass. Shrub
 - Prime planting, other. Plantation. Conifer. Bamboo. Other trees
 - Arise. Outwashed. Wooded. Surveyed tree
 - Boundary, international
 - State: domesticated, undomesticated
 - district, subdivision, taluk or taluq, tehsil
 - Boundary plane: surveyed, uncoloured
 - Height, triangulated station, point, approximate
 - Range mark: geodetic, tertiary, canal
 - Post office. Telegraph office. Overhead tank
 - Post house or telegraph bungalow. Circuit house. Police station
 - Camping ground. Forest: reserved, protected
 - Spaced names: administrative, locality or tribal
 - Hospital. Dispensary. Veterinary Hospital / Dispensary
 - Airfield. Helipad. Tourist site
 - Power line: with poles surveyed, with poles unsurveyed

Heights and Contours have not been shown.
A positive height, e.g., 50, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Parental streams in this sheet are generally fordable from October to June.
The kilometre scale numbers along railways are shown in black type, e.g., 10, whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 10.
The interrupted heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spot-levelled bench marks and may not be strictly in accordance with them.
Towns, shown only in this sheet, usually contain water from July to December.
The letter 'P' stands for Pura or Purana.
