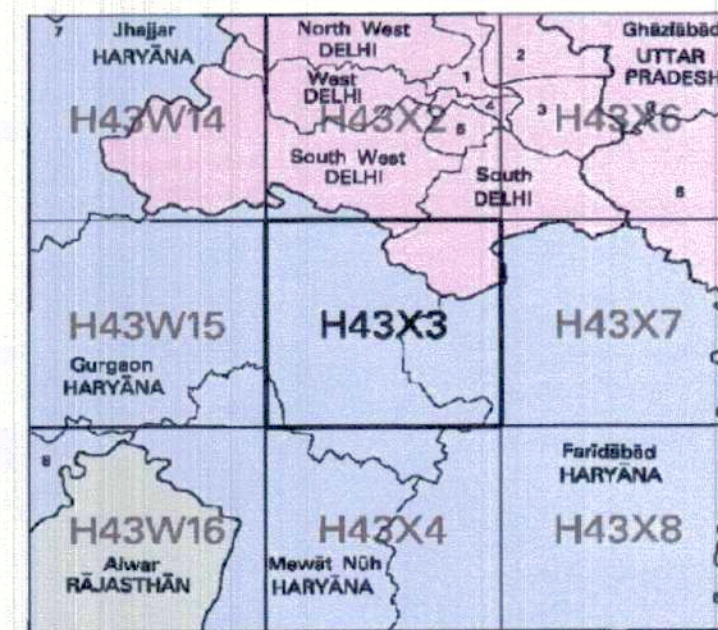

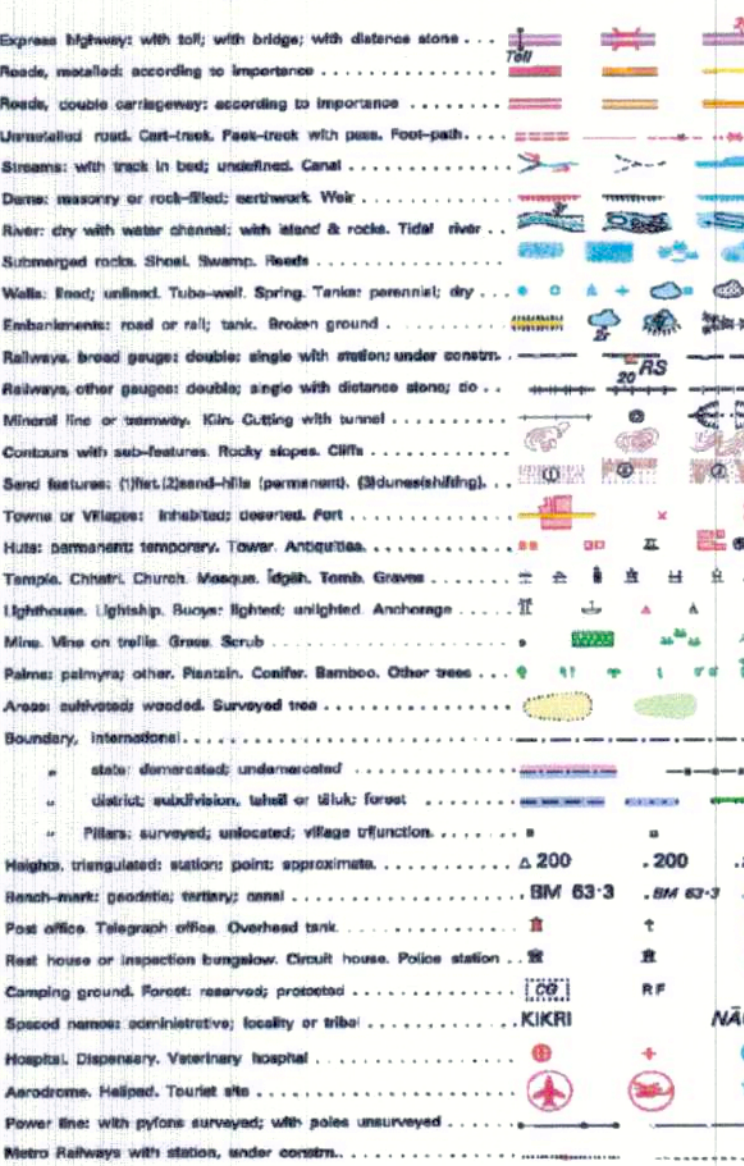

Tracks shown (y, y₁) and (x, x₁) usually contain wave from July to December.

Tracks (x₁, x₂) are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.

A height (h₁) above 0.00, marked along a track, indicates the height of the tip of the cone of the volcano.

Con-cuts and unimattar roads in the sheet are generally monotonic in dry season. Permission to travel in the area is required.

The triangulation heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled benchmarks and may not be strictly in accordance with them.

Contours are drawn at 100 ft intervals, except where they have been ascertained by the local officials on the ground but have not been verified by the Government concerned.

Important buildings are shown in the sheet.

A relative height, $\pm$ ft, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Contours in the Delhi State have not been shown in this sheet for want of reliable information.

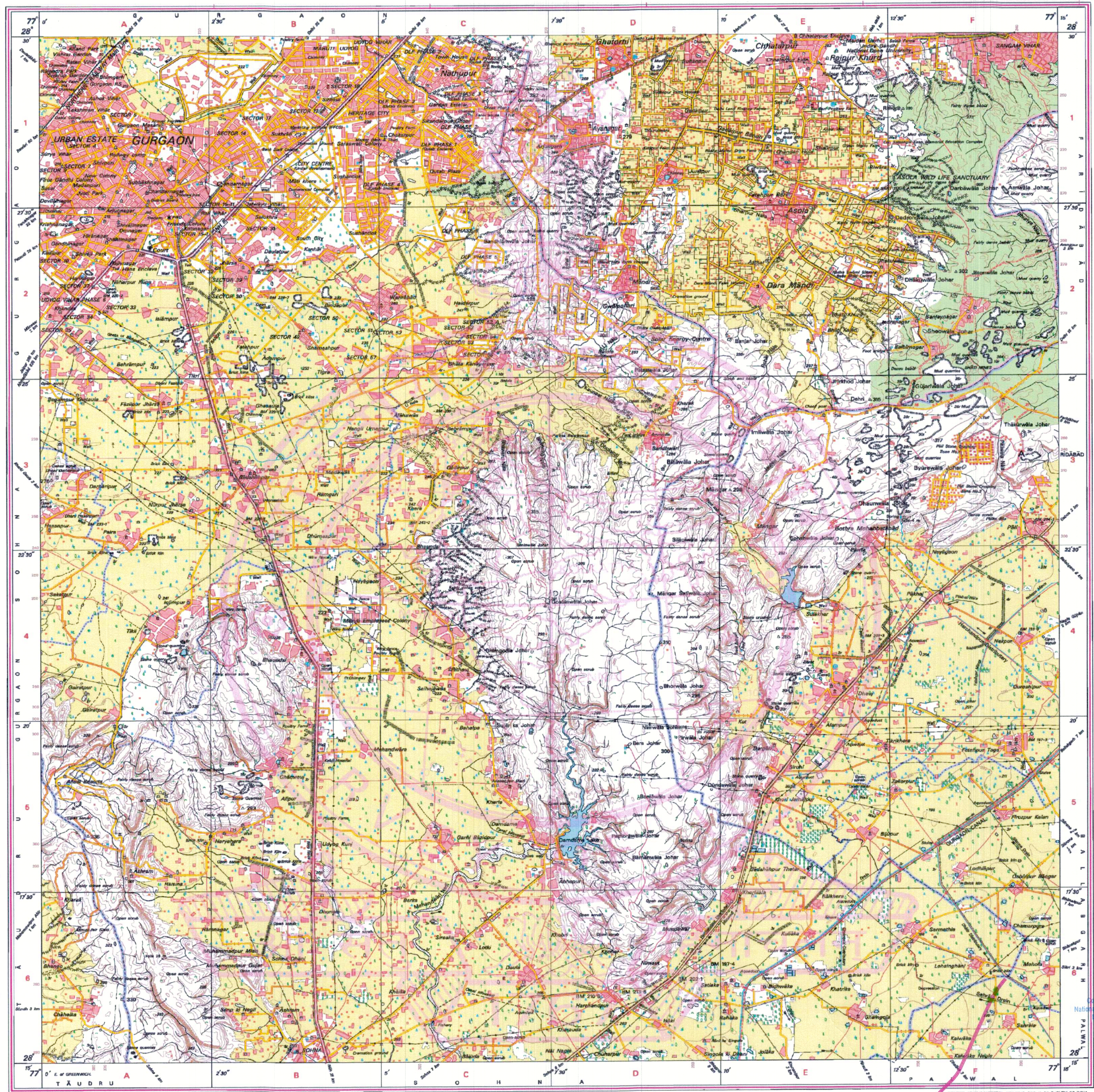
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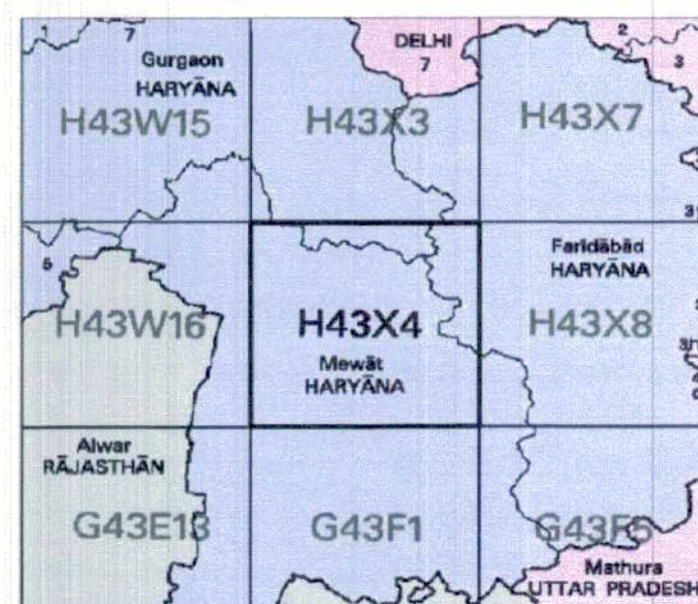

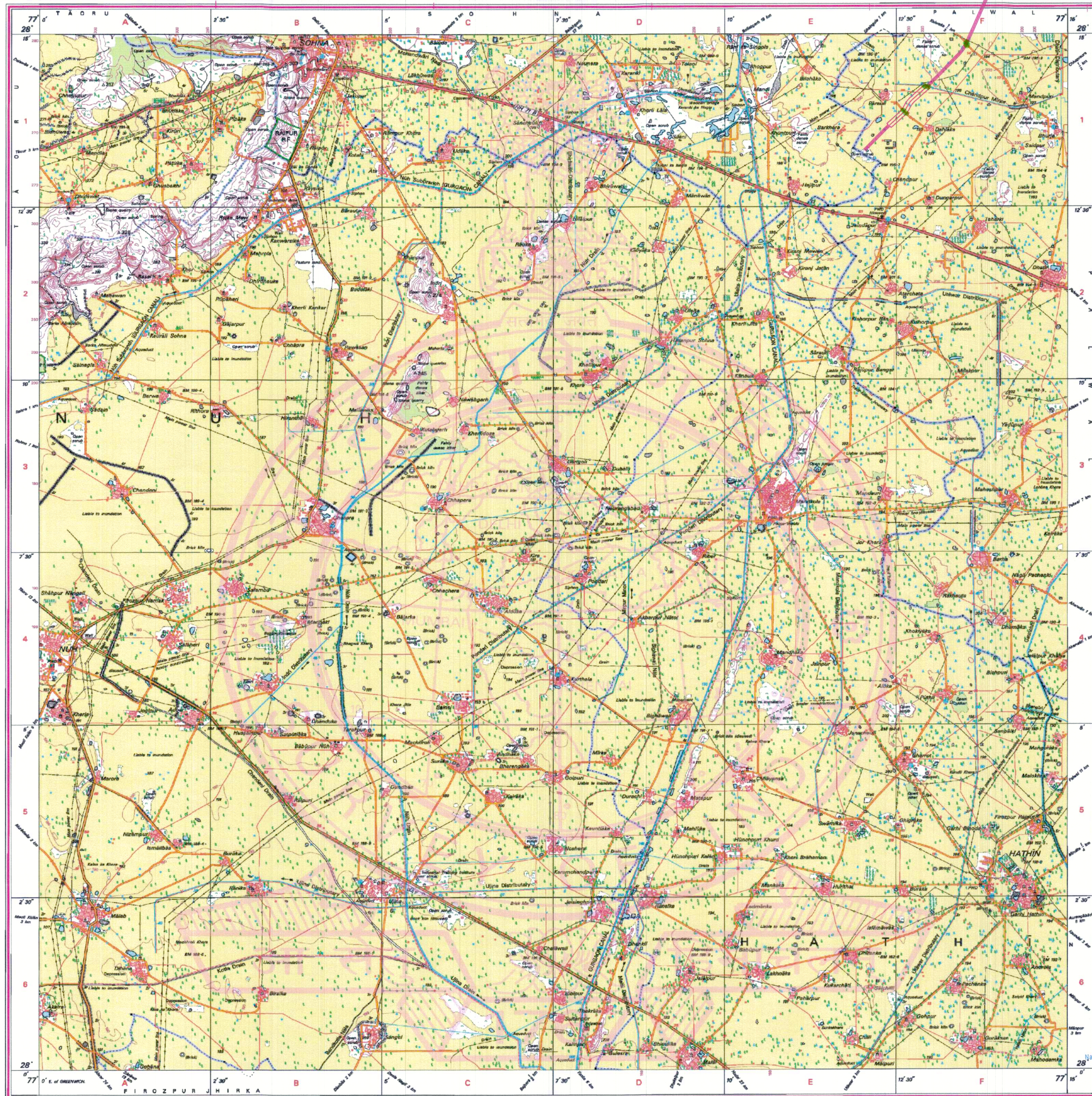
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
