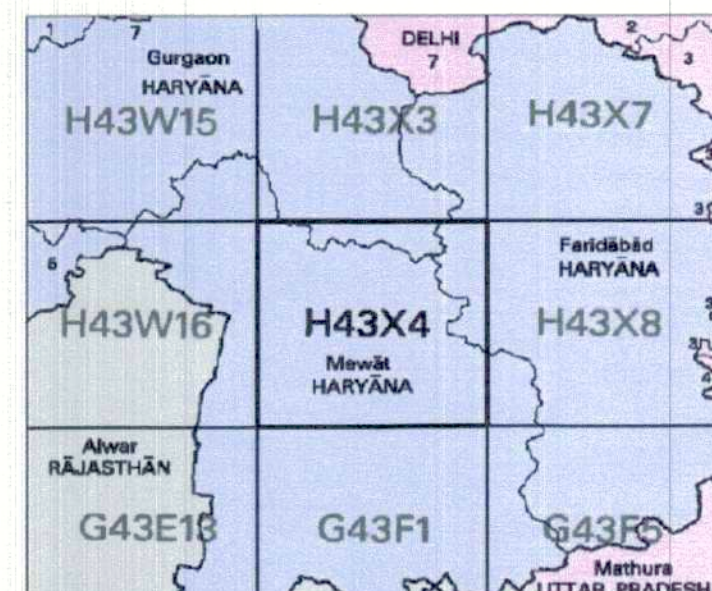

The idealized heights and contours in this sheet, have not been adjusted to the heights of the spot-levelled bench-marks and may not be strictly in accordance with them.
A relative height, e.g. $40 \pm$, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal underdrain above the adjacent bench-mark.
Tails shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to January.
Shades of grey are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
The black and red areas, and the areas in which the stream are generally considerable in dry season. Permission to use these areas is required from the irrigation authorities.
Canal distance scales are 1,000 feet apart and every existing 900 feet is shown.

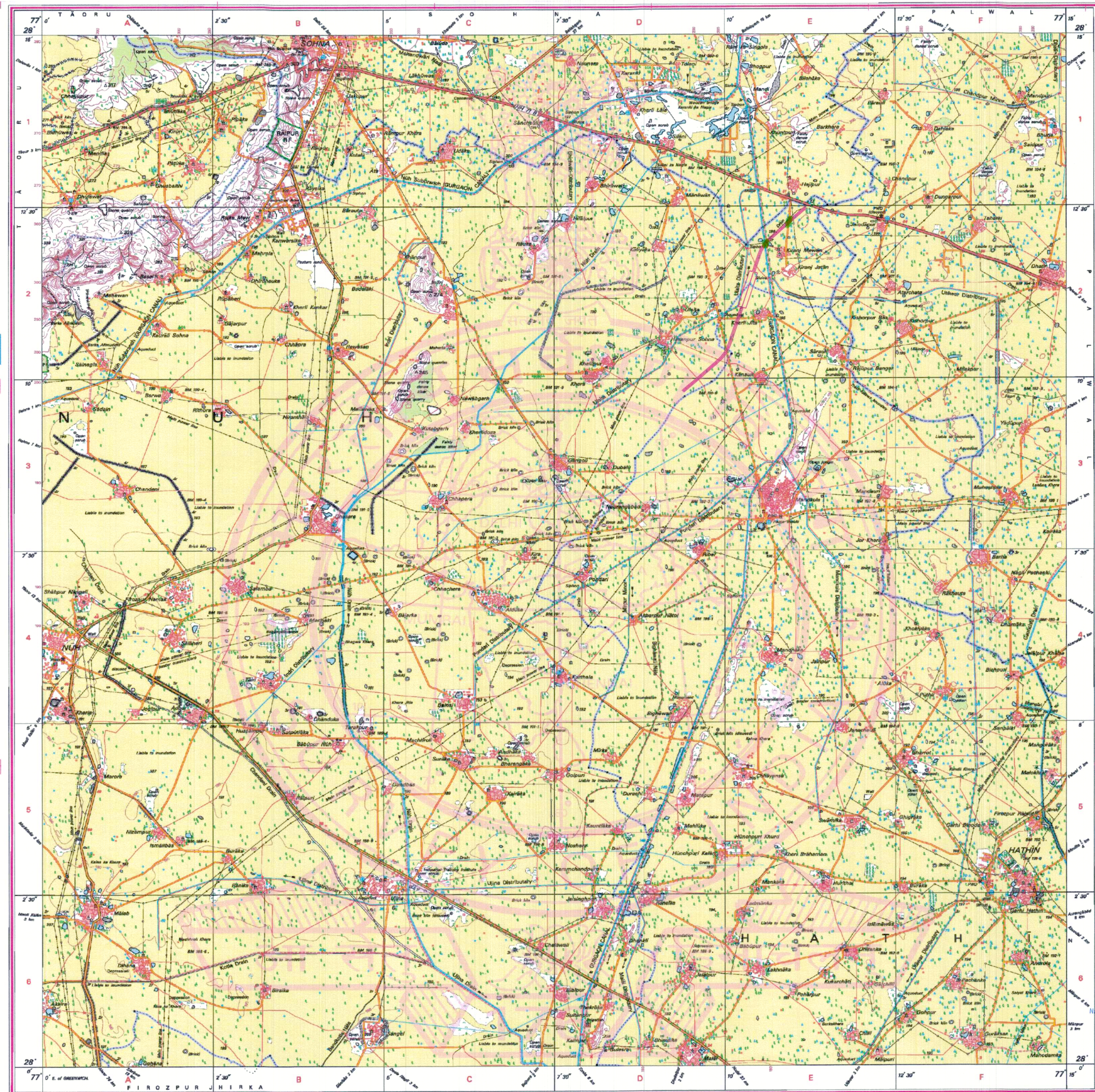
