Sub: Diversion of 16.6936 ha of forest land in favour of NHAI, PIU Pune for construction of Four Laning shifting of existing utilities (OFC, Electrical Cable, Water Pipeline) erection of street lights from Dive Ghat Hadapsar section of Palkhi Marg having Design Chainages from Km 220.900 to KM 234.150 (Hadapsar) of NH-965 in Pune District in the State of Maharashtra- regarding.

Sir.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Government of Maharashtra letter no. FLD-2022/CR-258/F-10 dated 18.10.2022 and APCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Maharashtra letter no. Desk-17/Nodal/Pune/I.D-13942(NH)/1396/2022-23 dated 05.09.2022 on the above subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government, 'in-principle' approval was accorded by the Central Government vide its letter of even number dated 24.11.2022. The State Government of Maharashtra has now submitted a report on the compliance of conditions stipulated in the 'in-principle' approval and requested the State Government to grant final approval to the proposal.

In this connection, I am directed to say that on the basis of compliance report submitted by the Government of Maharashtra letter no. FLD-2022/C.R.258/F-10 dated 21.06.2023 and the State Government of Maharashtra letter no. FLD-2022/CR-258/F-10 dated 31.10.2023, submitting reply to query raised vide this office letter of even number dated 18.09.2023, the Central Government hereby accords 'final approval' under Section— 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 16.6936 ha of forest land in favour of NHAI, PIU Pune for construction of Four Laning shifting of existing utilities (OFC, Electrical Cable, Water Pipeline) erection of street lights from Dive Ghat Hadapsar section of Palkhi Marg having Design Chainages from Km 220.900 to KM 234.150 (Hadapsar) of NH-965 in Pune District in the State of Maharashtra subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- i. Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged;
- ii. Compensatory afforestation
 - a. Compensatory Afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 34.00 ha. degraded Forest Land at Gut no. 27, 96, 97, 98, 99, Village-Sarafwadi, Taluka- Indapur, District- Pune at the cost of the User Agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species along with 10% RET species of Pune District shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided. At least five water bodies shall be constructed in the form of tank/



stop dams etc if the same are not available in the area or in nearby vicinity. Further, if existing tanks/ stop dams are available and needs desilting/ repair; same shall be carried out to meet the water requirement of wild animals throughout the year;

- iii. User agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department. Maximum numbers of trees in outer RoW will be kept intact:
- iv. The State Government, Maharashtra/ Nodal Officer (FCA), Maharashtra shall ensure settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (No. 2 of 2007) before issuing an order for handing over of forest land to the User Agency as per Rule- 9 (6) (b) (ii) of Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022 dated 28.06.2022;
- v. To improve the Forest/ Tree cover and to reduce pollution in the State, as mandated in National Forest Policy, 1988 and Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 respectively, the User Agency with involvement of Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMC's) and in consultation with local DCF shall raise at least 25,000 seedlings of forestry species along with bamboo, fruit bearing, medicinal, ornamental, and indigenous/local for 10 years. At least 50% of seedlings shall be planted in the vicinity of project area and remaining 50% of seedlings shall be distributed among villagers as per choice of villagers. The concerned JFMC's shall maintain record of plantation/ seedling distribution to villagers;
- vi. The trees having bird nests shall not be felled without written permission from the DCF concern both in forest as well as non-forest land;
- vii. The Forest Department shall carryout the avenue plantation by planting 8 feet tall suitable forest species outside RoW passing through the Forest Areas as well as non-forest areas as per the IRC norms at the cost of User Agency;
- viii. For smooth movement of wildlife and cattle the all hume-pipes shall be converted in to the box-culverts of minimum size of 2 x 3 meters in both forest and non-forest areas:
- ix. Overburden shall not be dumped outside the width of the road. The muck generated in the earth cuttings will be disposed of at the designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be allowed to roll down the hill slopes;
- x. Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/ Forest Areas;
- xi. User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable;
- xii. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government;
- xiii. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- xiv. Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;
- xv. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer;



- xvi. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work;
- xvii. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less;
- xviii. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal;
 - xix. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department, or person without prior approval of Govt. of India;
 - xx. Concealing factual data or submission of false/ fabricated data and violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guideline F. No. 11-42/2017-FC dt 29/01/2018:
 - xxi. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife;
